However, that darkness is not necessarily negative.

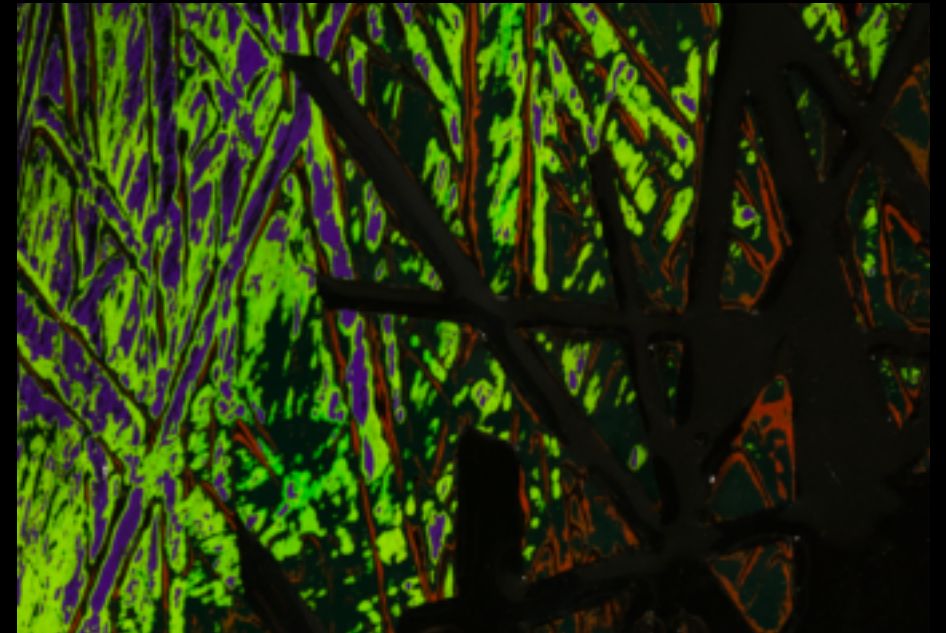
It is something that is concealed from our consciousness.

By the imminence of disappearing.

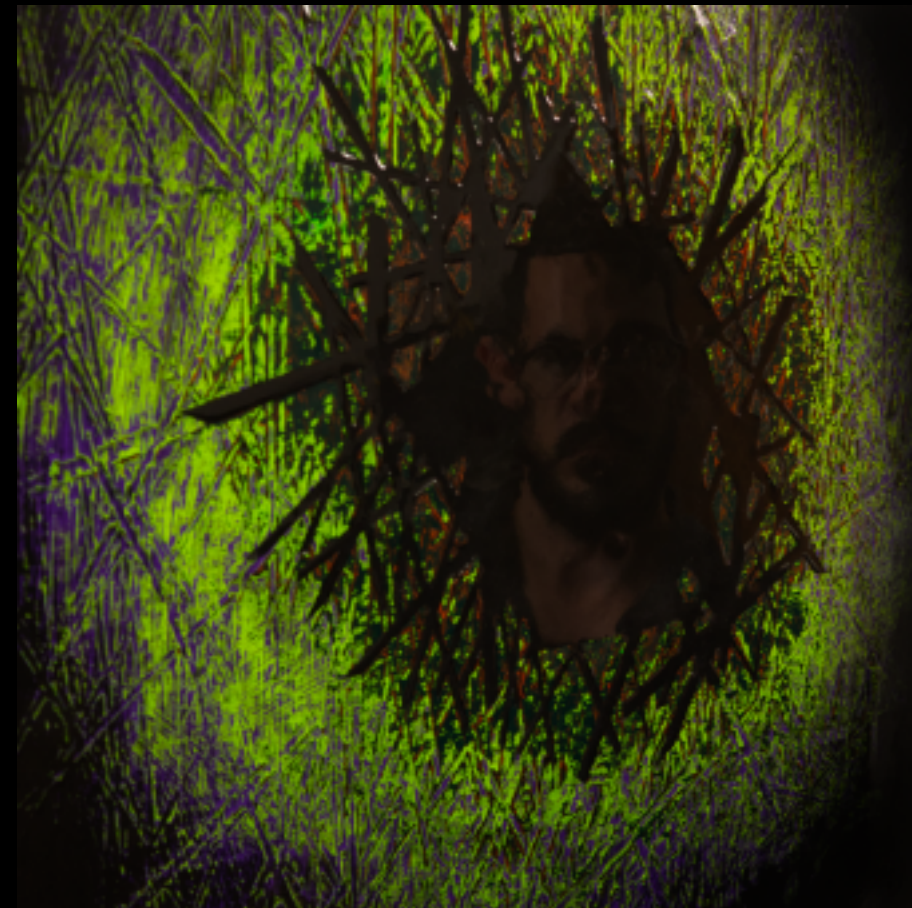
And there is only one way to keep existing.

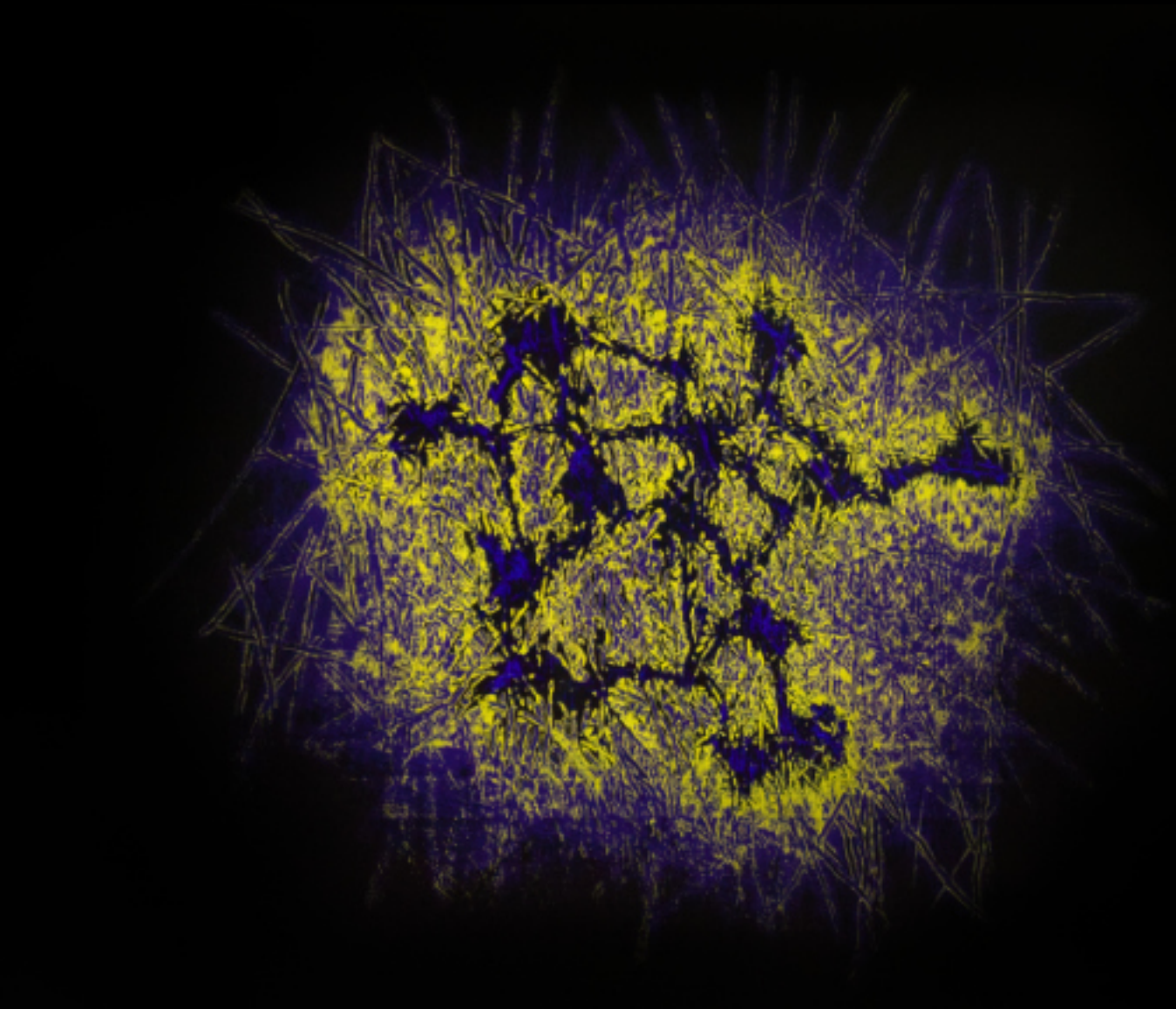
To evoke your fears, anxieties, and deepest emotions.

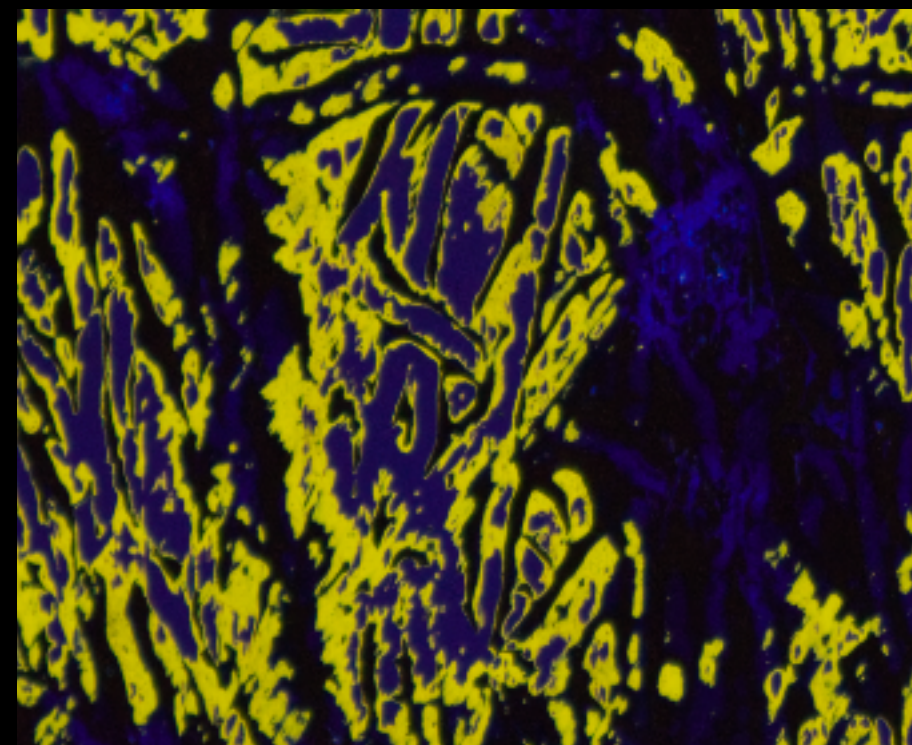
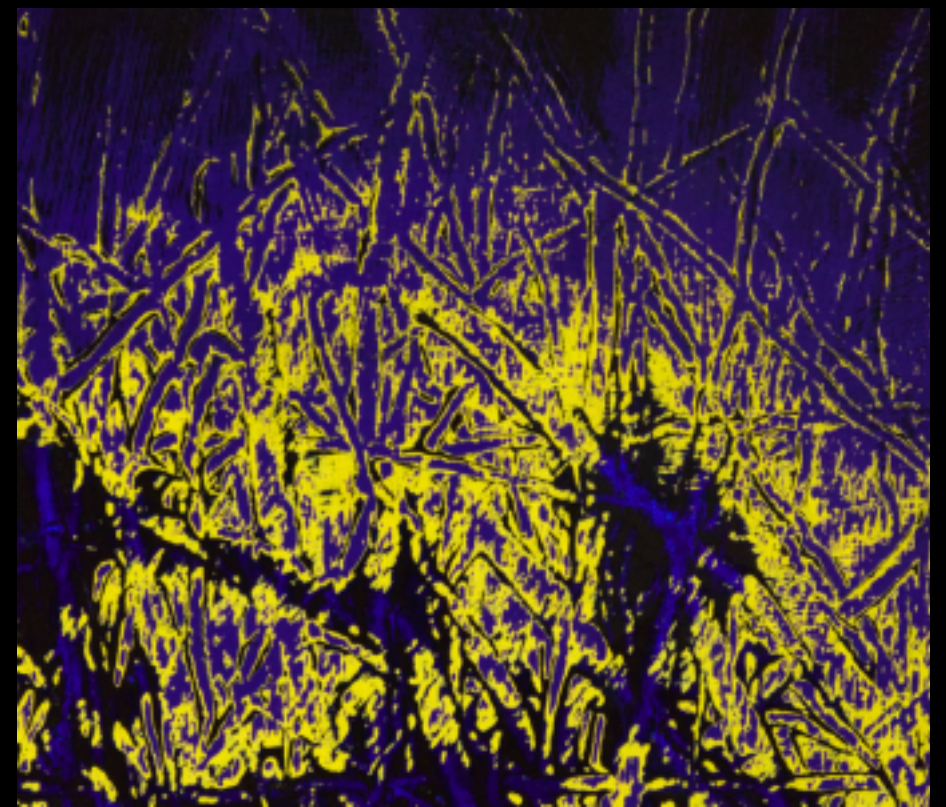

According to Color Theory, yellow and blue are the perfect opposing colors, when it comes to the relationship with light.

Yellow has an expansive nature, as when mixed with white, it can achieve an enormous spectrum of light yellow.

However, when it comes in contact with the slightest black, it will immediately lose its brightness and quickly change into a different color.

Blue is the exact opposite. If you add black, you can achieve almost infinite shades of dark blue, giving it an astonishingly deep and introspective nature.



During every moment of our life, we are surrounded by death. Millions of cells, insects, animals, people are constantly dying without our knowledge.

And those deaths do not impact us in the slightest.

We may be mildly impacted by the death of people we know. But we are deeply impacted by the death of the people we connect to. Because ultimately, to die is to disconnect.

Death is the Great Disconnection.

But death also has the power to create True Connections.

Suffering creates empathy, which connects people in a deeper way than positive emotions ever could.

Life Dienamics is the expression of this reality, as yellow vibrantly expands in every direction with the energy of life, but it is the deep, profound blue that creates a network of connection, empathy and belonging.

Obscurious evokes the fear of encountering darkness, and honors the curiosity required to confront it.

You attempt to look, but there is only darkness.

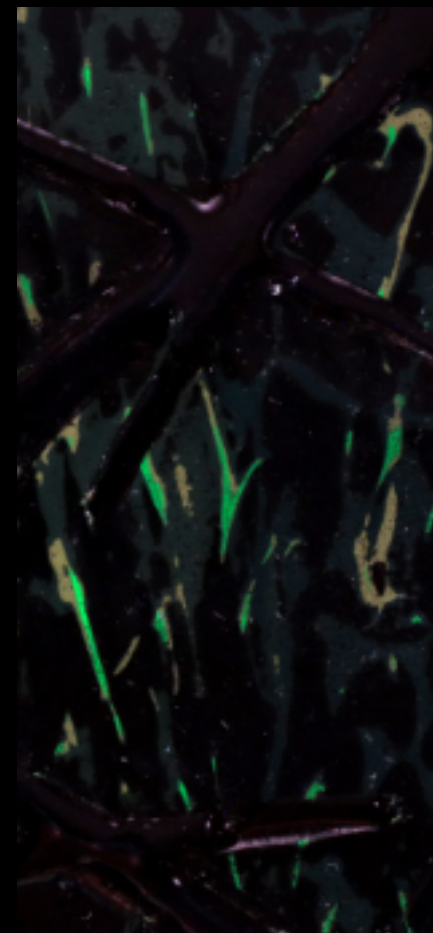
Darkness, and the certainty that you are not alone.

When there is daylight, there is absolute certainty of what is prey, and what is predator; of what we can pursue, and what we should avoid.

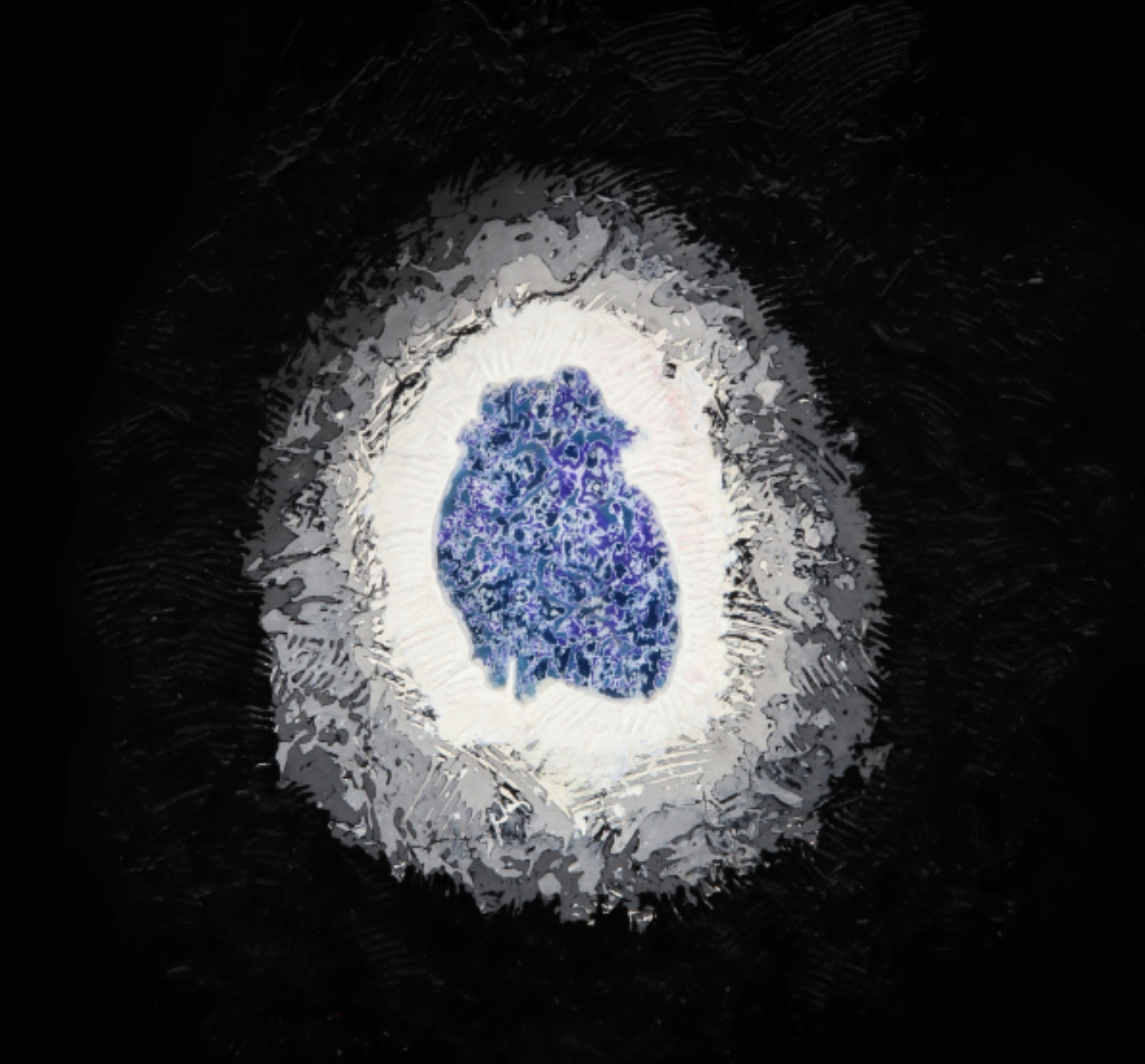
But when darkness comes, as the consciousness slowly turns into unconsciousness, knowledge slowly turns into unknown, and safety quickly turns into fear.

This ancient, primal fear was the reason of mankind's physical survival.

But if let unchecked, fear can become mankind's psychological imprisonment.

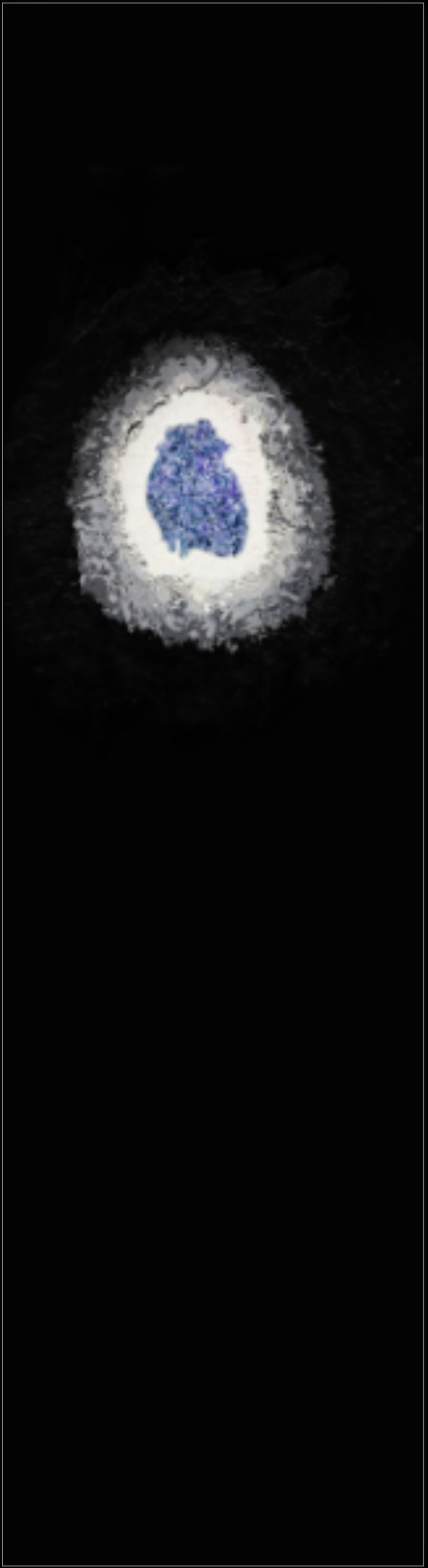
Obscurious summons the ancient fears embedded in our DNA, allowing us to connect with a time where we were both hunters and prey.

This experience creates a meditative space to connect with raw fear, using curiosity to venture beyond it, into uncharted inner territory.



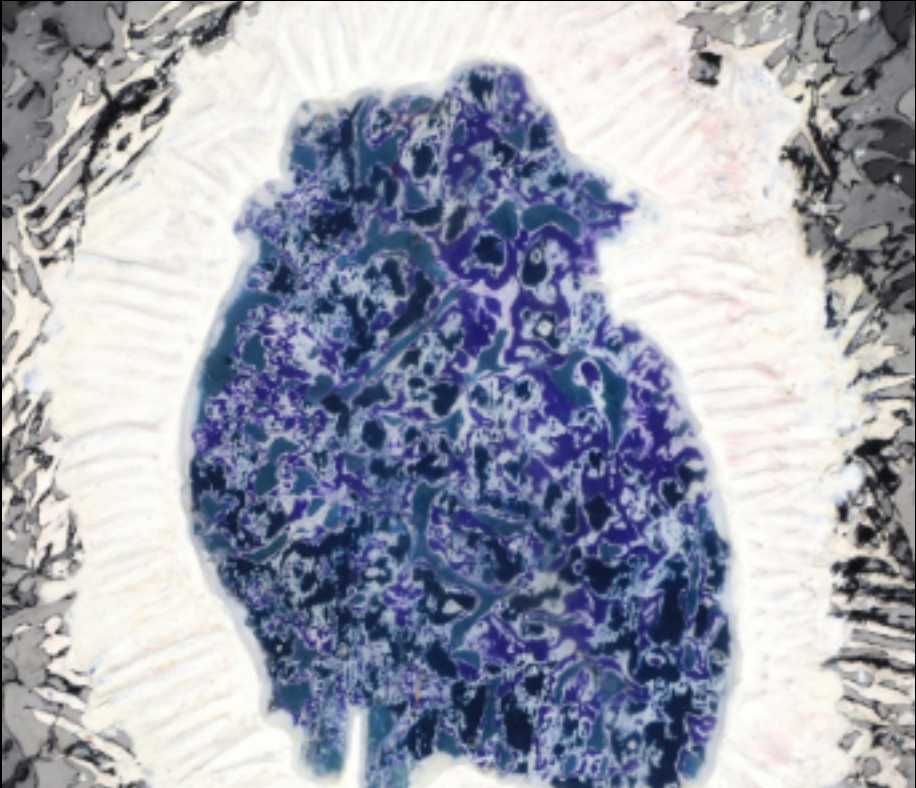
A limb that's exposed to ice for a long time becomes frostbitten.

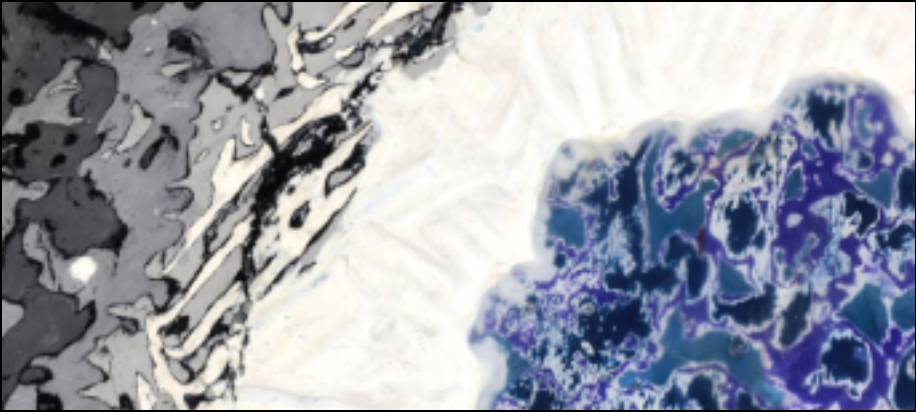
The canvas, measuring the same height and width of Nepomuceno, has the central element located precisely where the artist's heart is. This chilling monolith is an honest and raw utterance of grief.

Colored in freezing metallic colors, and covered in a transparent layer of epoxy resin, the heart has become stagnant, numb, glacial.



The greyscale crevasses that surround the heart, are textured by the comb that Nepomuceno used to brush the hair of his family members in palliative care, to provide the last remnant of

dignity before the imminent death.
Frostbeaten reflects on what remains.
A cold, dense, beaten heart.



Surrounded by a halo of lacerations, a black void reflects the observer, summoning a profound reflection on all the darkness one strives to avoid.

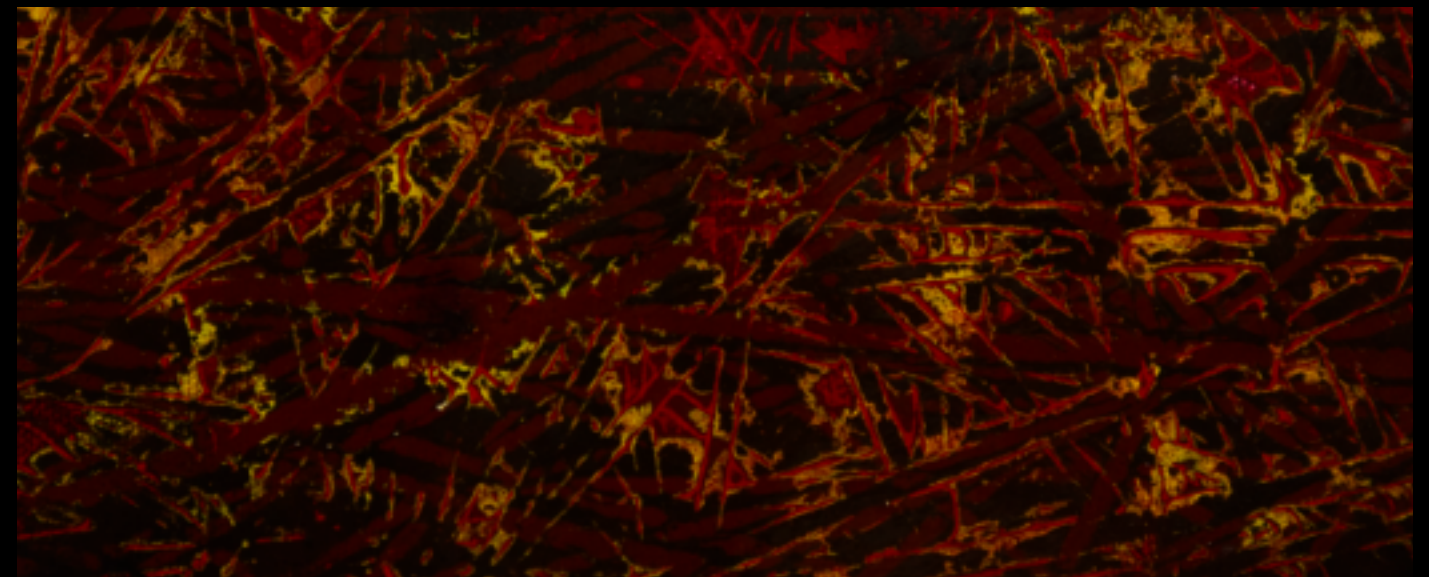

It expresses the need to overcome pain, without the will to confront it.

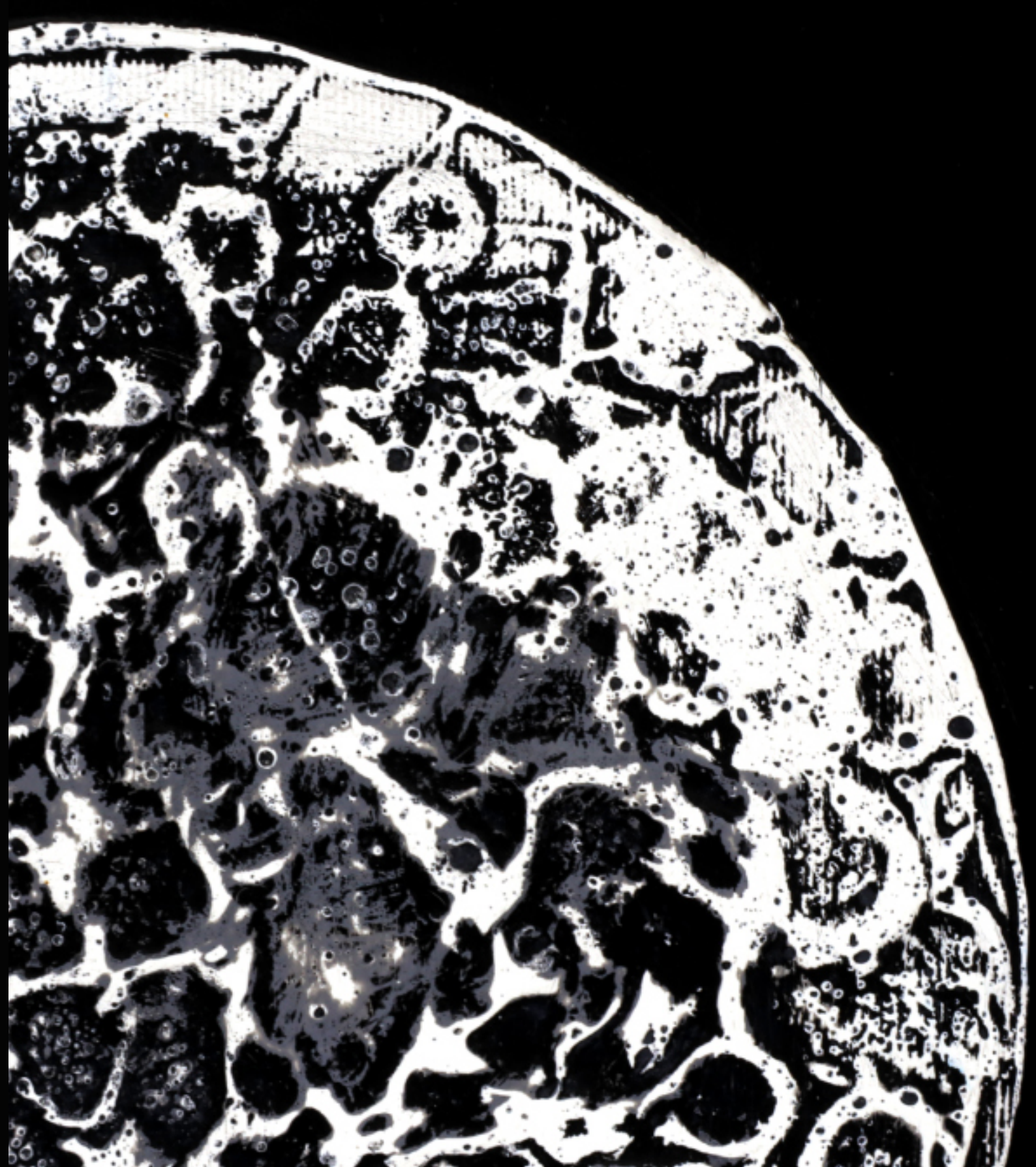


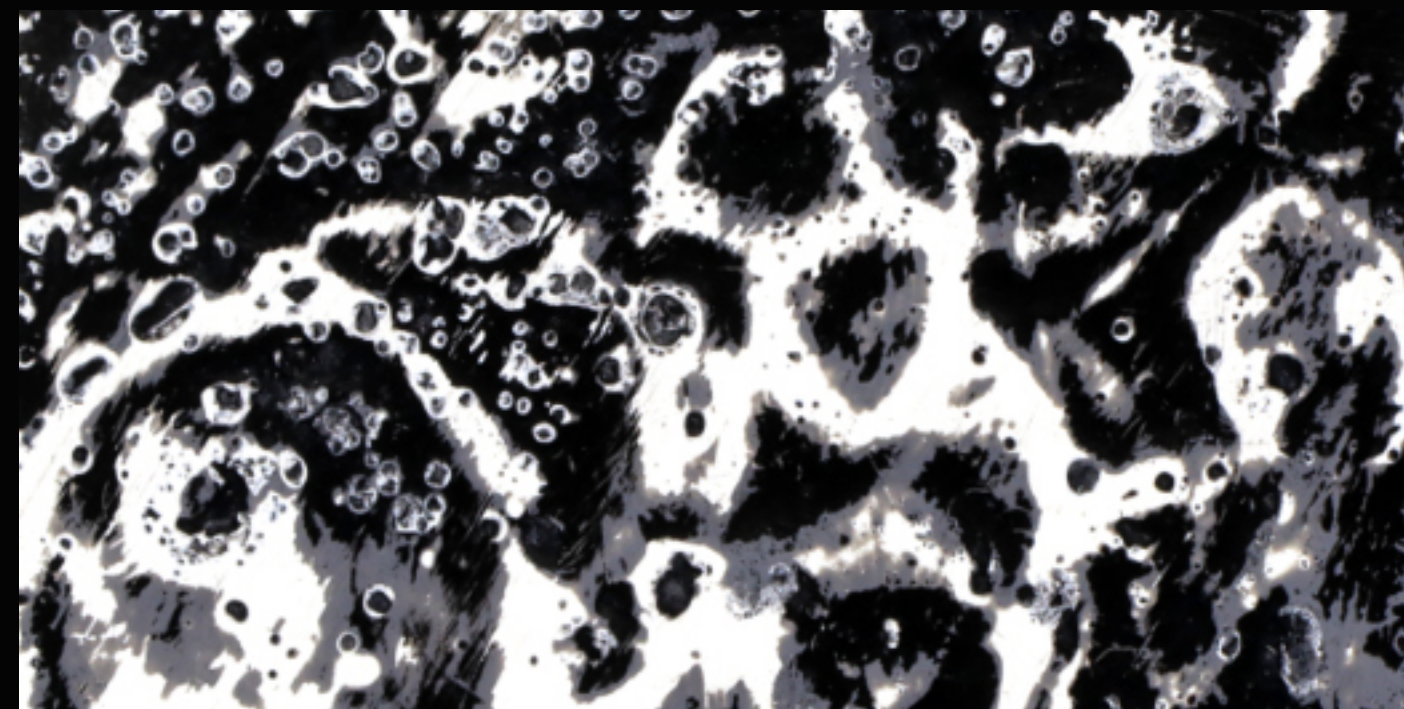
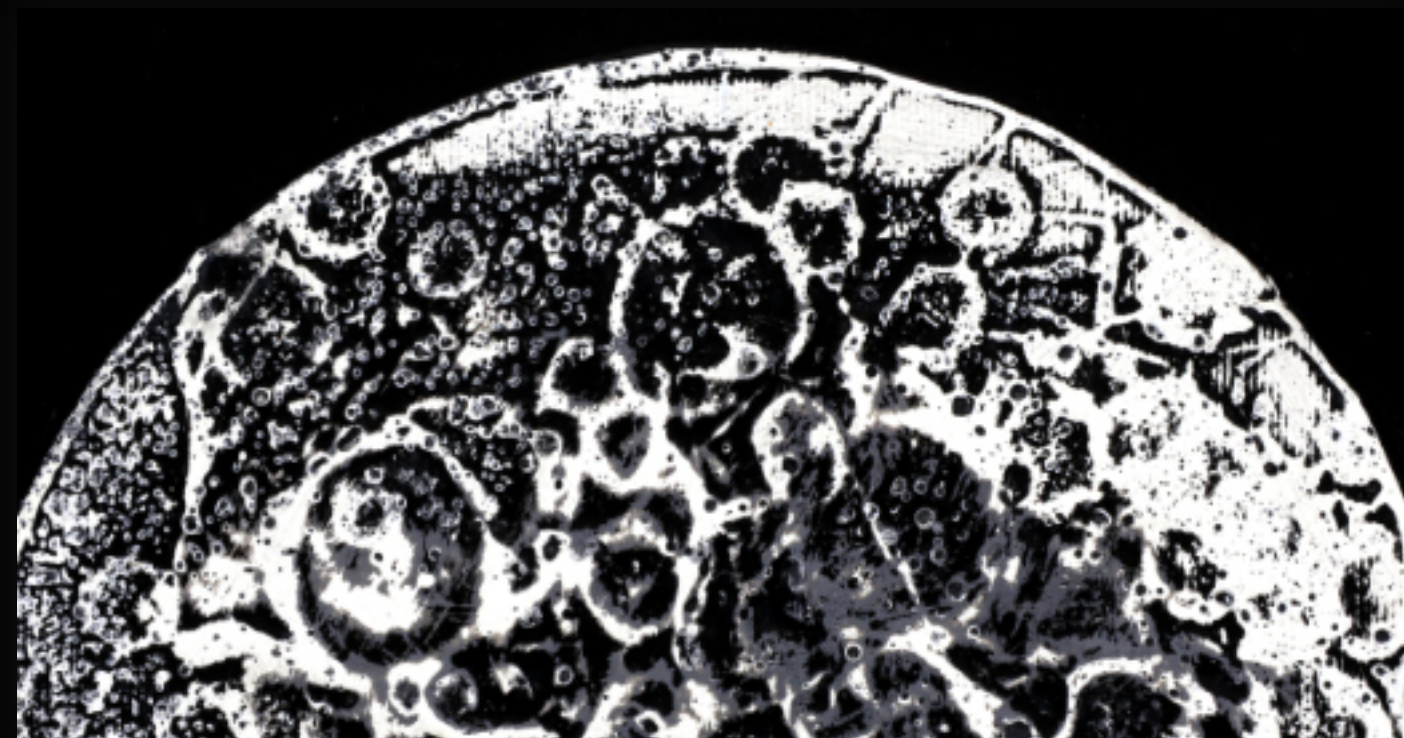
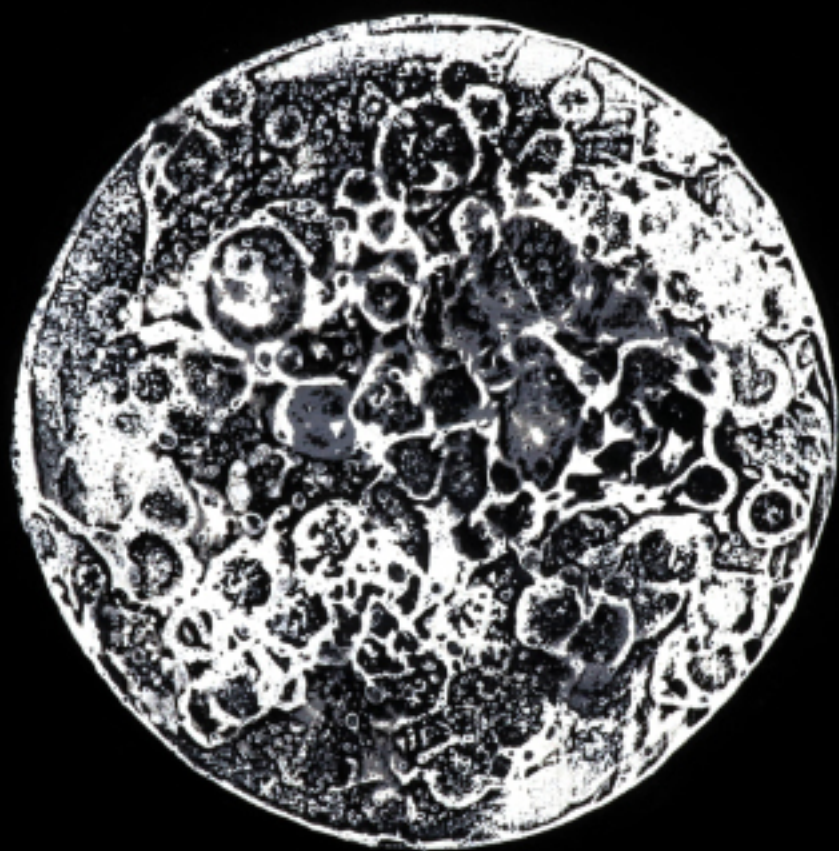

Gravity and Heat



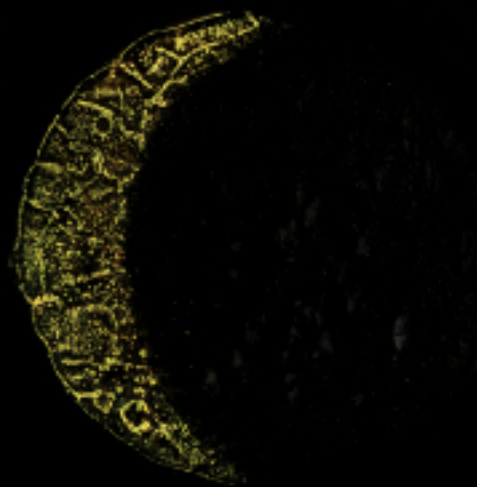

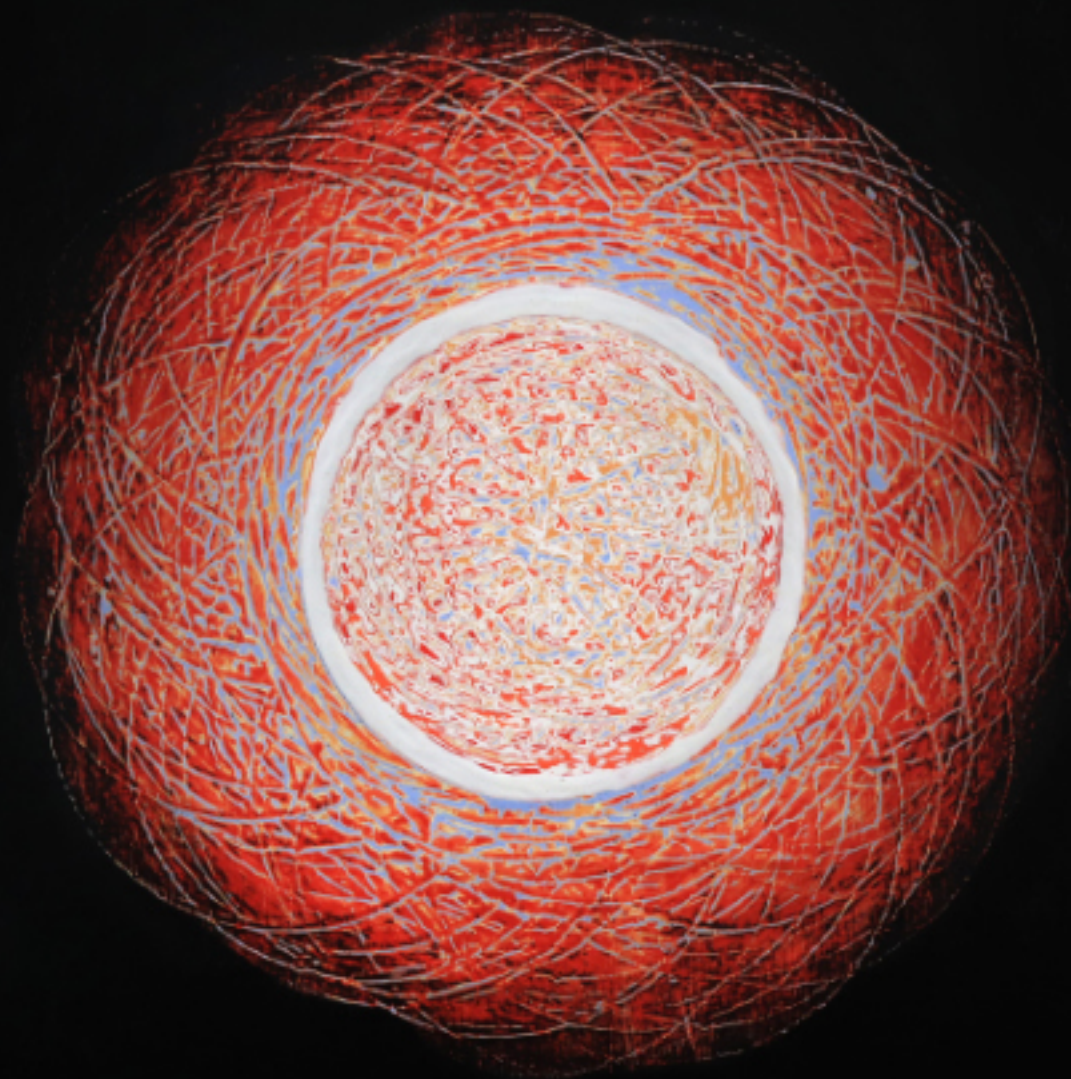
WHITE HOLE

that the deeper you go, the brighter it gets.





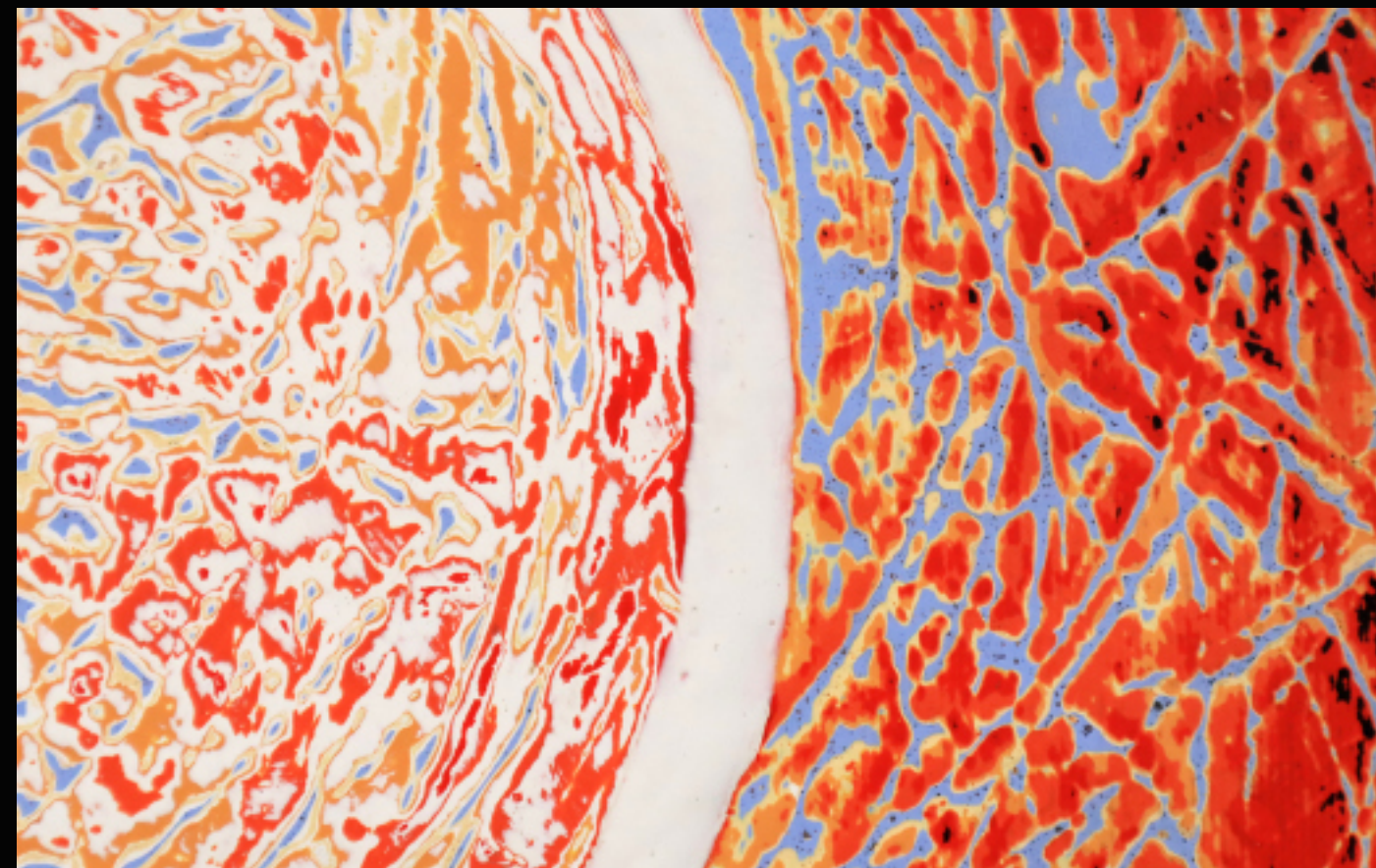
From the constellation of Scorpio, Antares is the 15th brightest star in the night sky, and is on the last stage of its life.

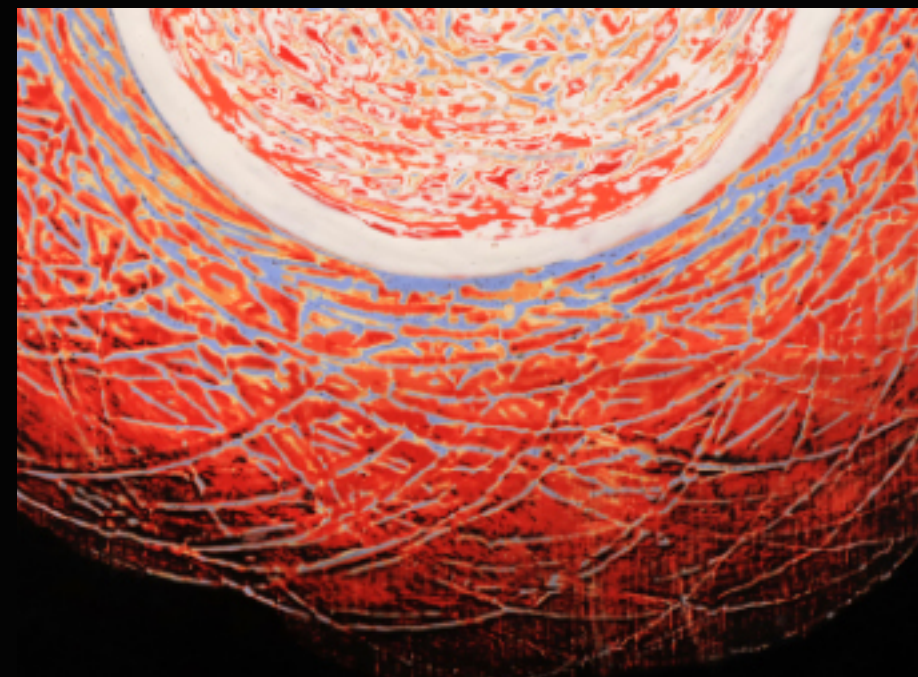


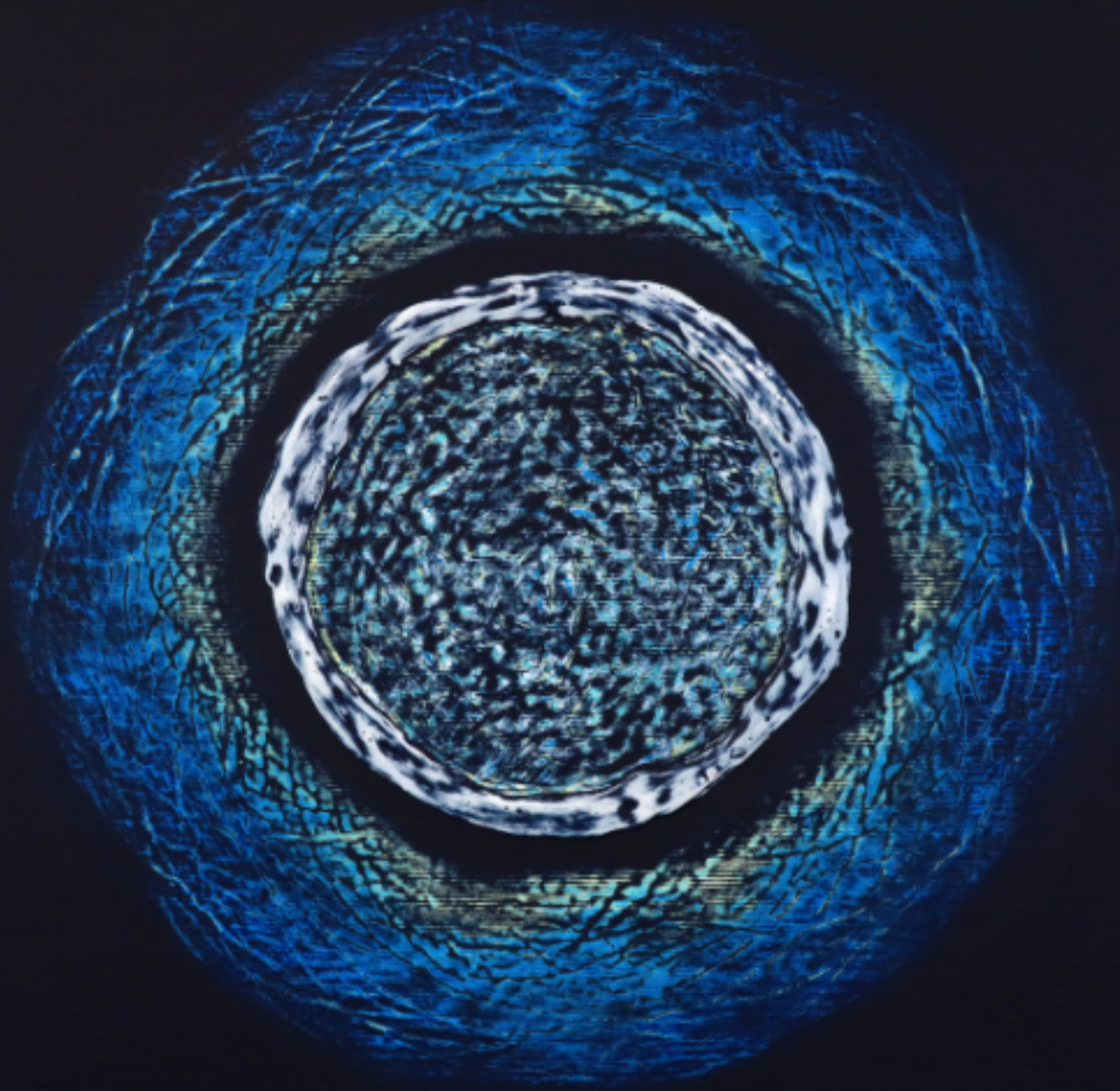
A star is the combination of two forces: the inward motion of gravity, that compresses the nucleus into temperatures so high, that they create a nuclear reaction; and the outward explosion of that nuclear reaction, that expands its outer layers. Just like our breathing, in and out.

But as the star grows older, it will eventually run out of fuel, and its outward motion will stop.

In that precise moment, gravity wins. When all that's left is the inward force, the star collapses into itself, spectacularly exploding into a Supernova.

Antares represents this balance, through a piercing mixture of warm and cold colors, and a composition that seems to be both expanding and imploding, invites the contemplation of the life and death that is constantly happening. In and out.





Named after the brightest star of the night sky, Sirius pays homage to its often forgotten sibling, Sirius B.

Also known as a White Dwarf, it is the corpse of a dead star, and what the Sun will eventually become.

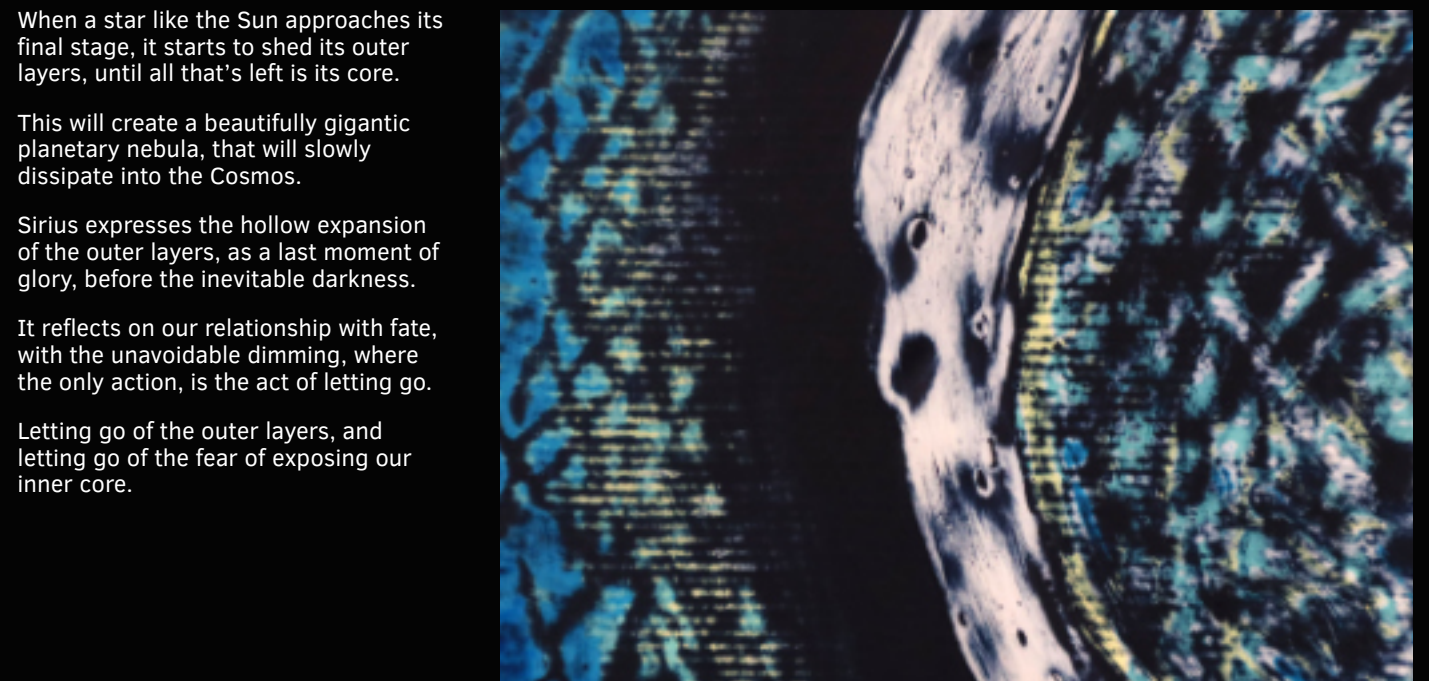
When a star like the Sun approaches its final stage, it starts to shed its outer layers, until all that's left is its core.

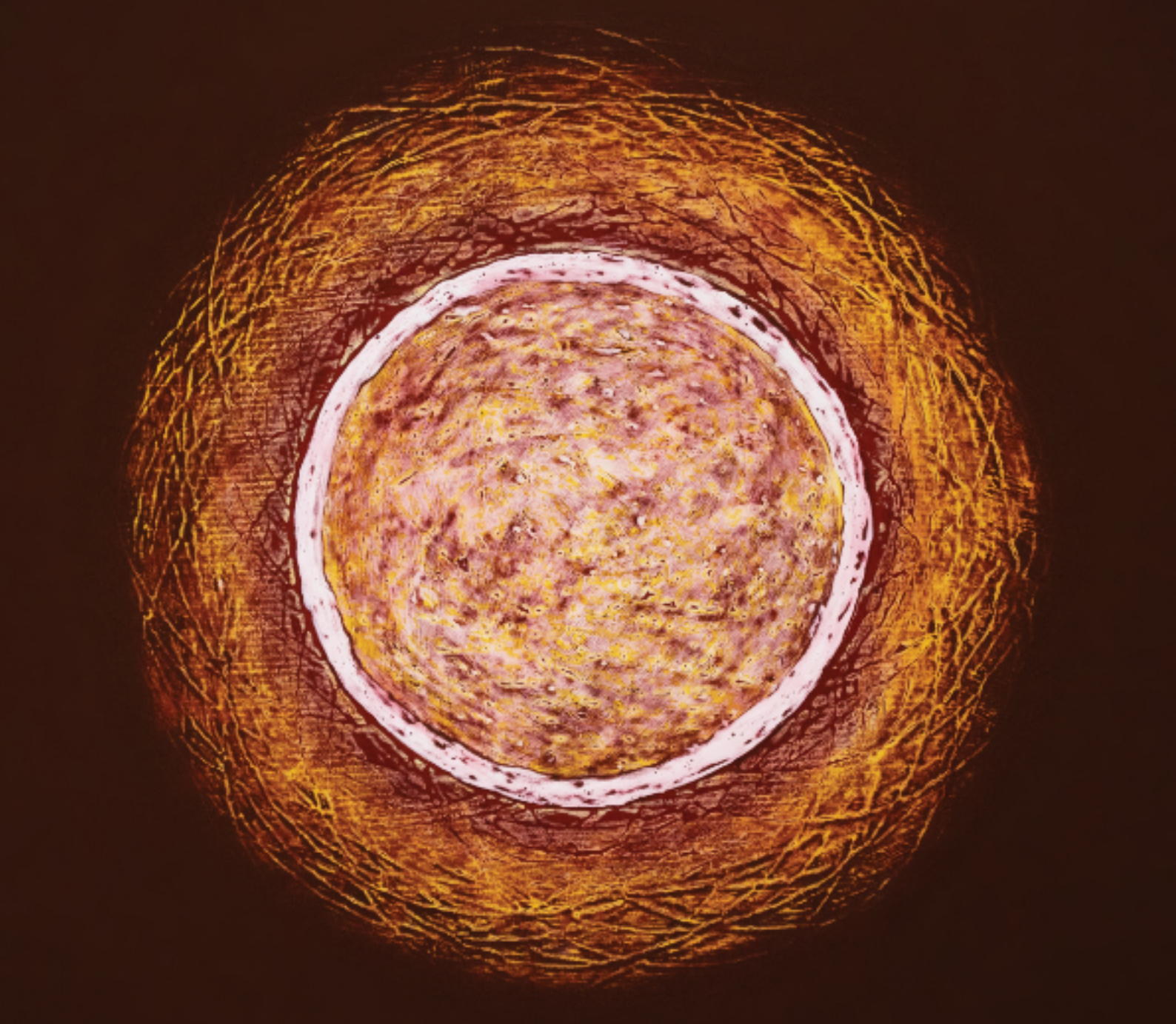
This will create a beautifully gigantic planetary nebula, that will slowly dissipate into the Cosmos.

Sirius expresses the hollow expansion of the outer layers, as a last moment of glory, before the inevitable darkness.

It reflects on our relationship with fate, with the unavoidable dimming, where the only action, is the act of letting go.

Letting go of the outer layers, and letting go of the fear of exposing our inner core.





Luhmann represents a Brown Dwarf, a celestial object that is much more massive than a planet.
But not massive enough to become a star.

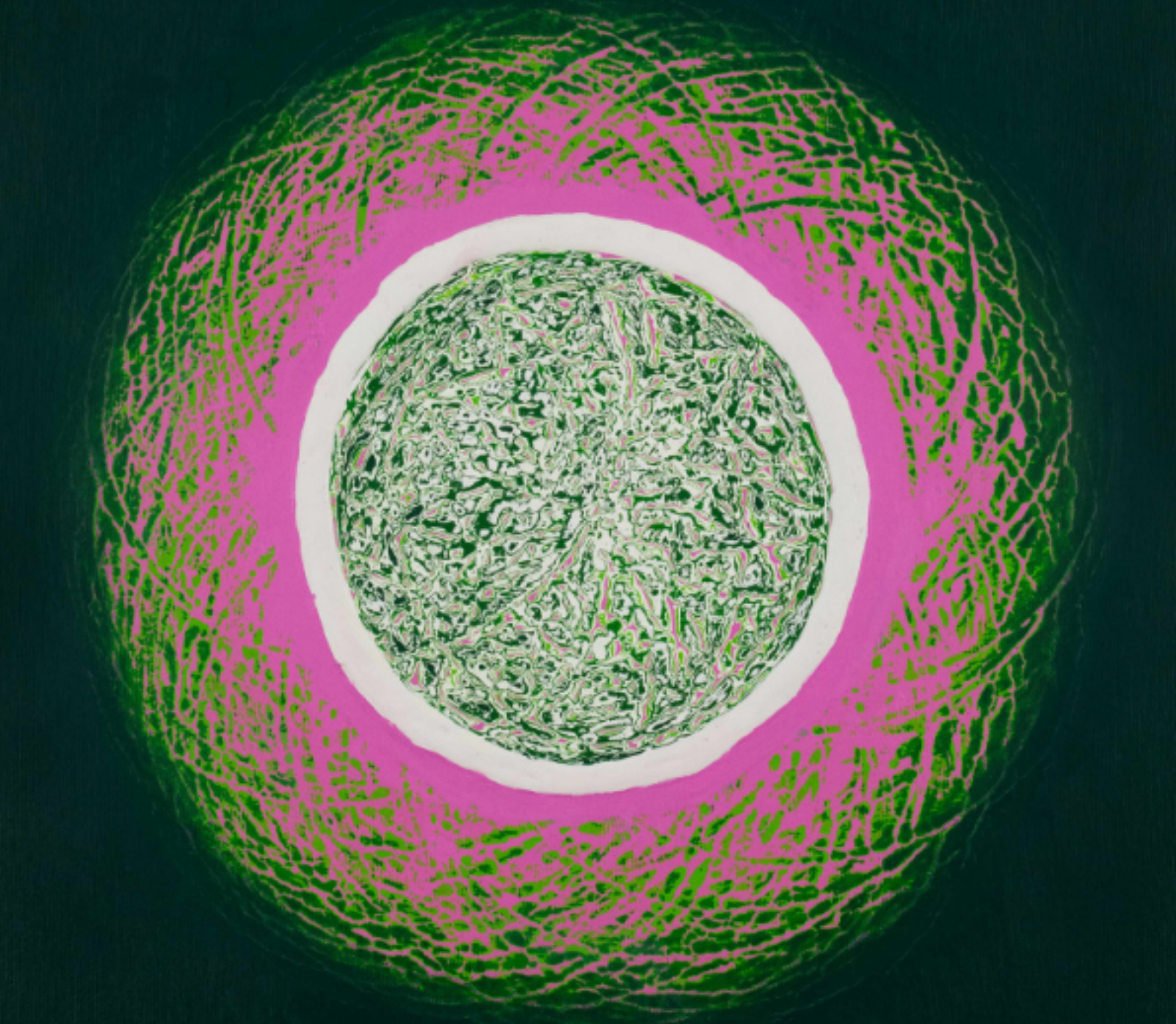

Named after the Brown Dwarf system closest to Earth, Luhmann is, by coincidence, phonetically similar to both "Lumen", a unit to measure brightness, and "Human".

The warm, calming and nurturing qualities of the brown color, humanize the essential characteristics of the Brown Dwarf. Being substantially more massive than a planet, but not enough to be a star, they represent the archetype of household or a community leader. They have innate light of their own, enough to improve the lives of the surrounding people, a caring nature and a kind presence. Unable to affect the lives of a society, they are the keepers of a precious sense of community.





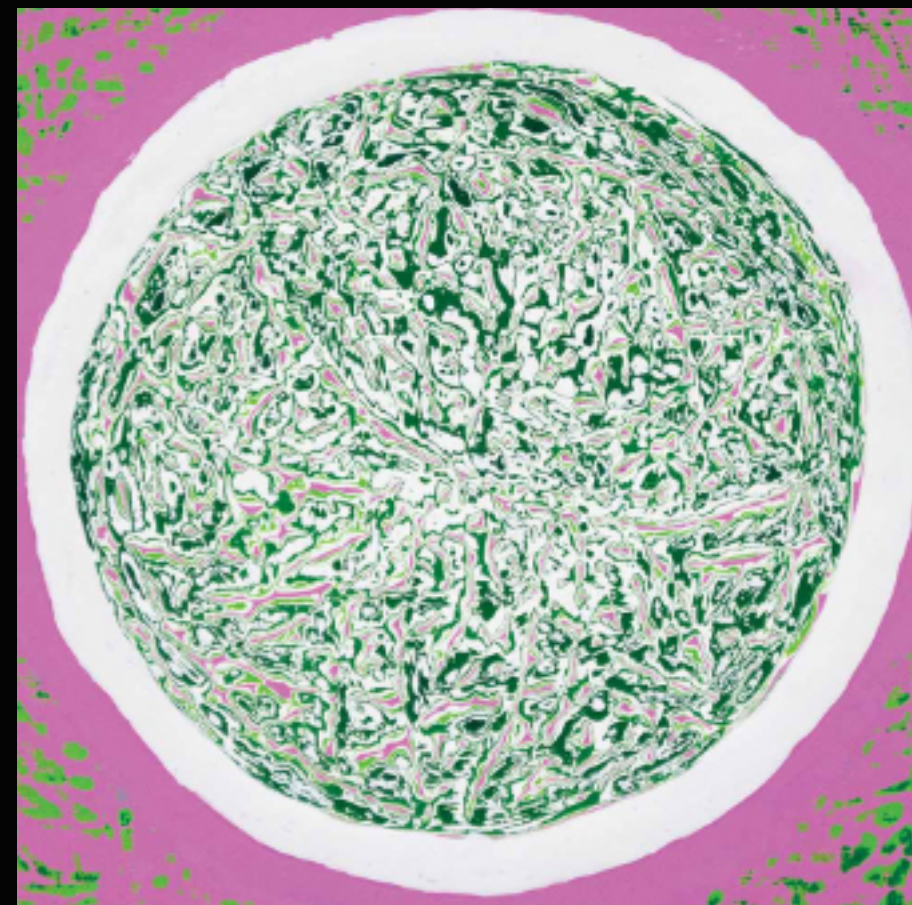
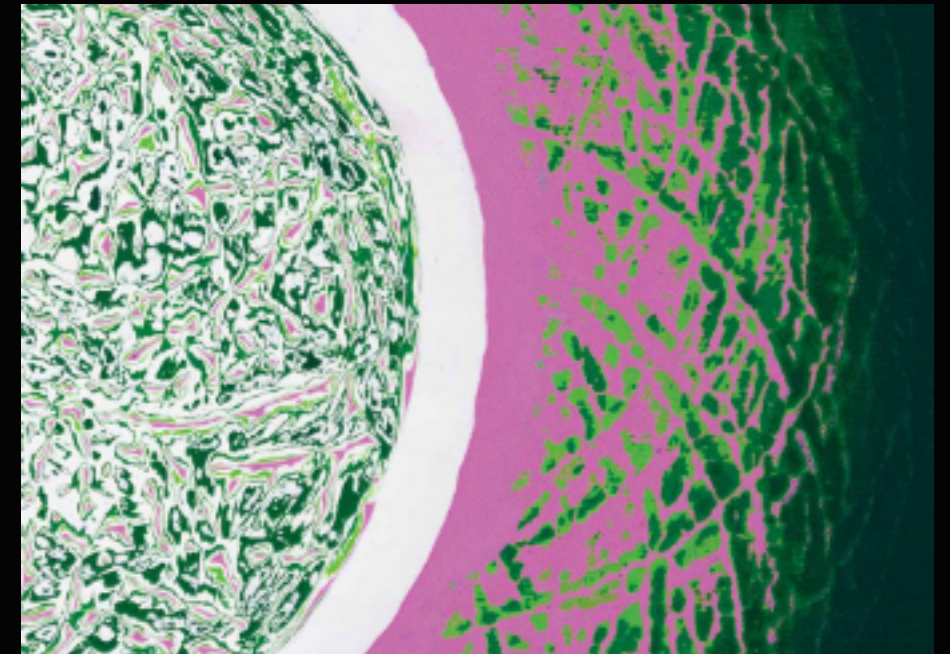
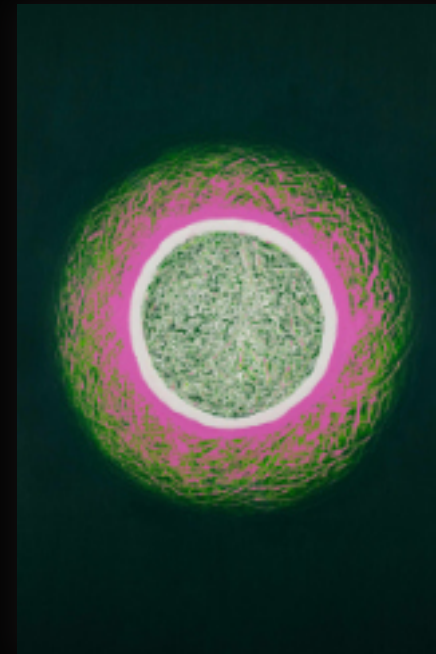
The Einstein Rosen Bridge is the first theoretical Worm Hole.

Deep embedded into our DNA, and amplified into every decision, we have one single drive: to pursue what we crave, and to avoid what we fear.

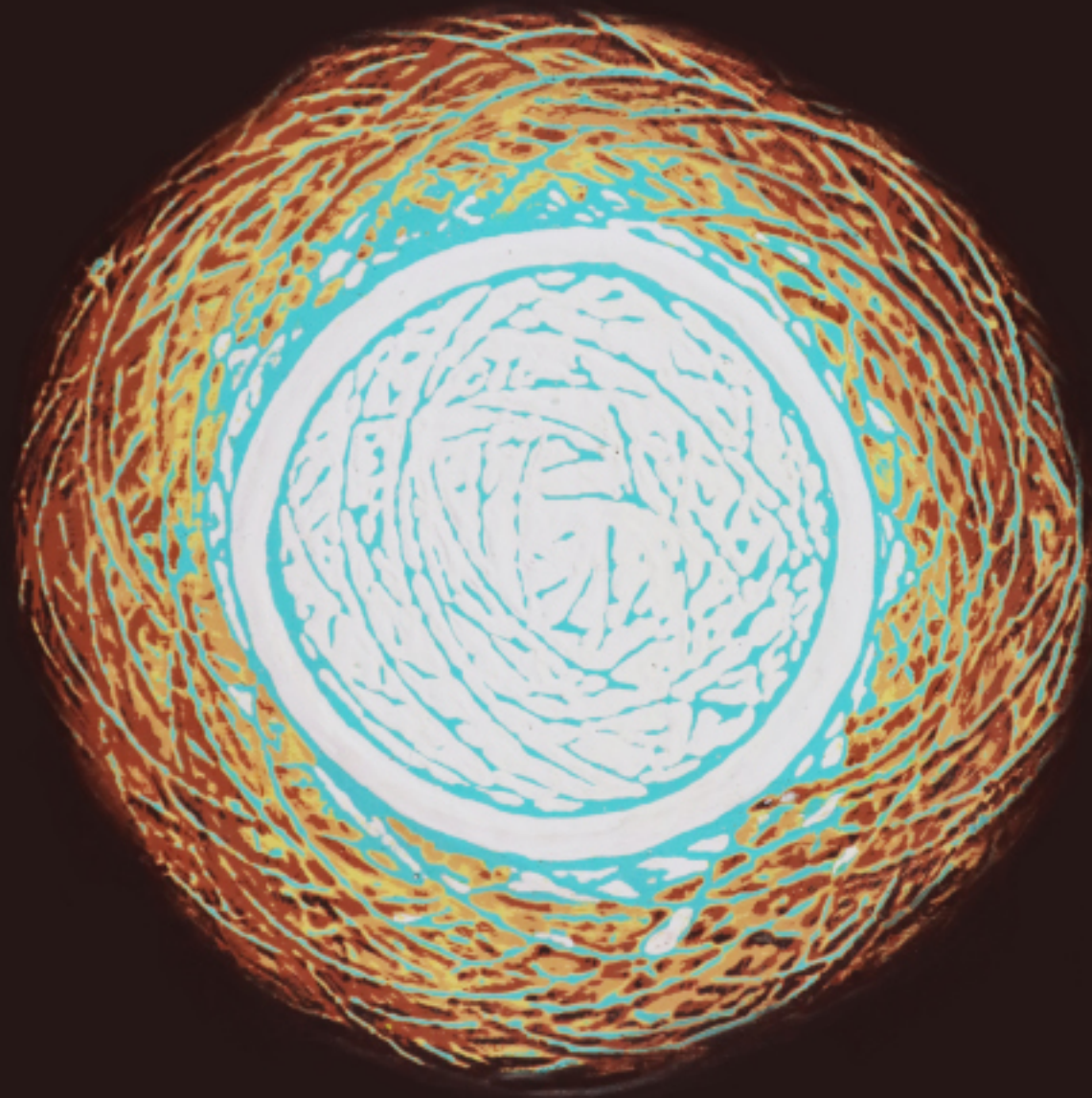
In other words, our single drive is to avoid what is.

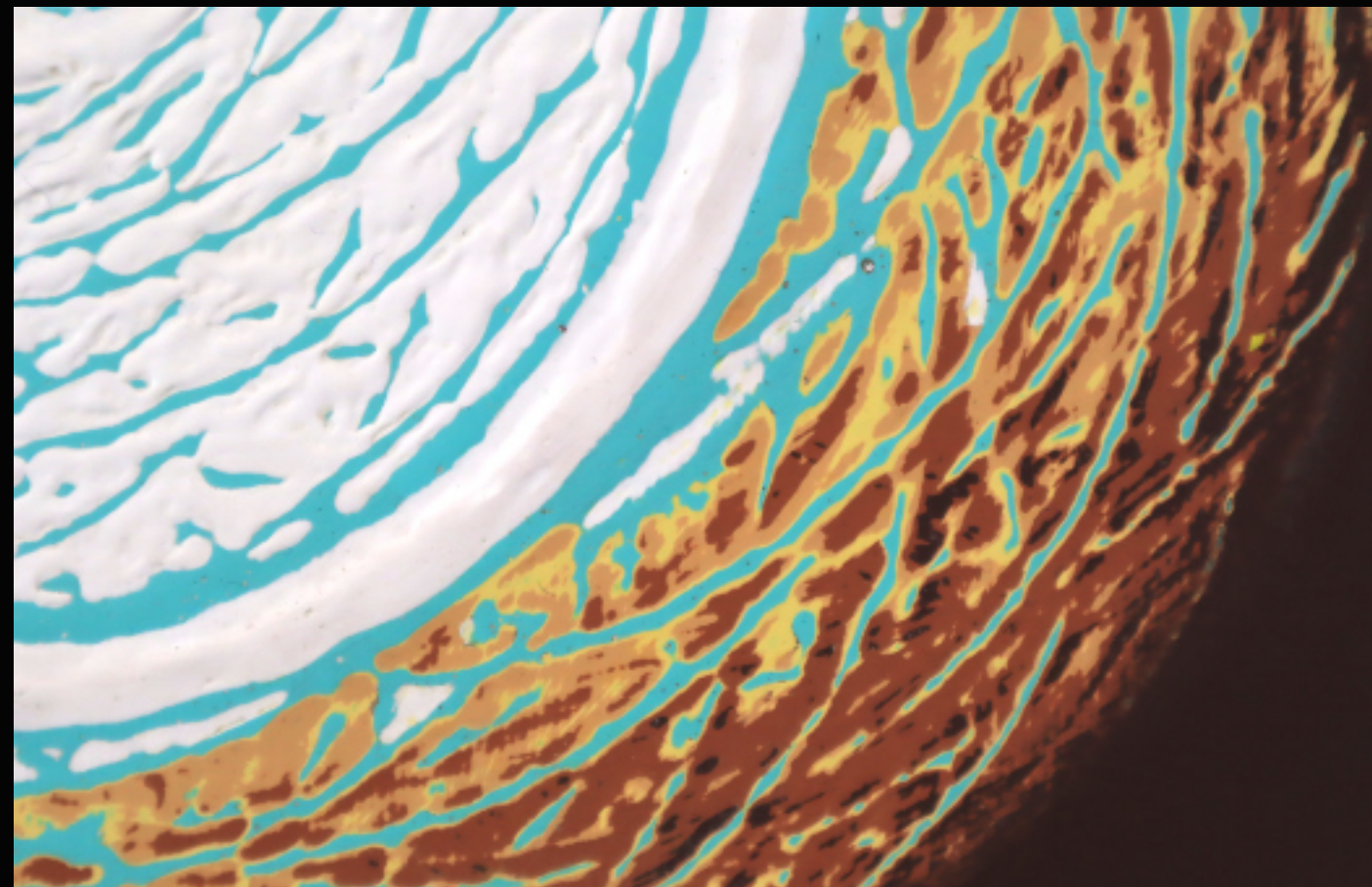
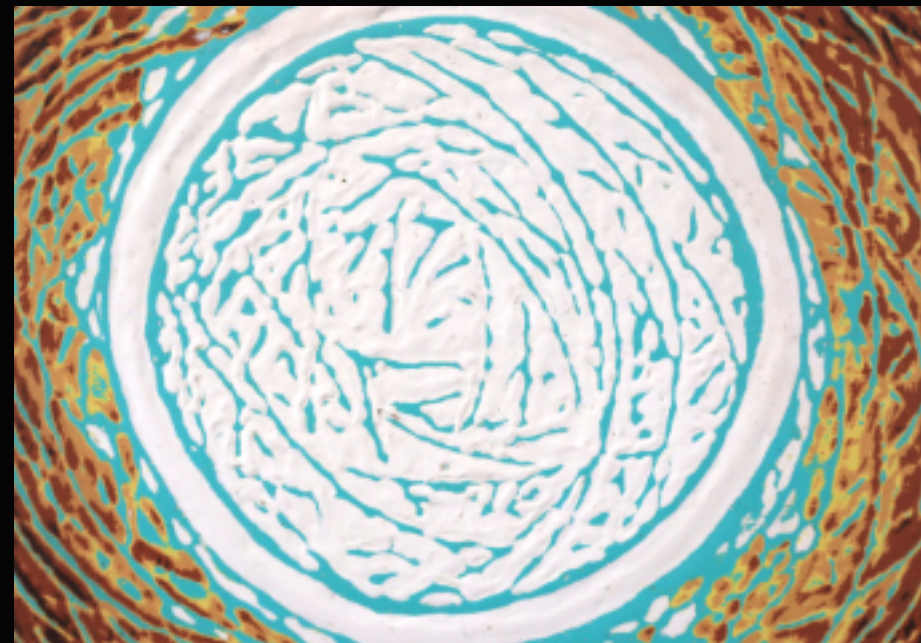

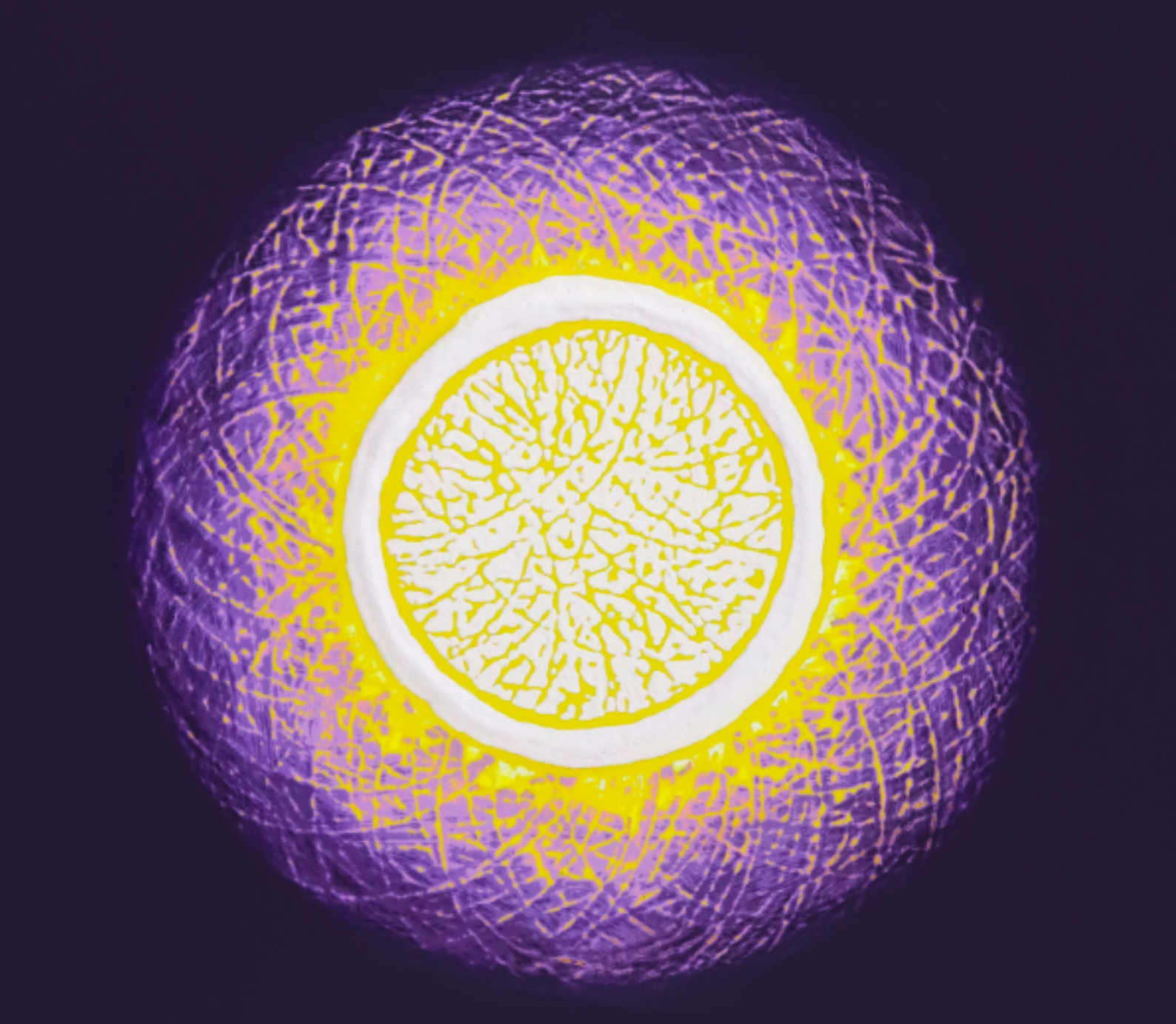

Amongst the people that we orbit, it is vital to understand that there is a habitable zone that needs to be respected.

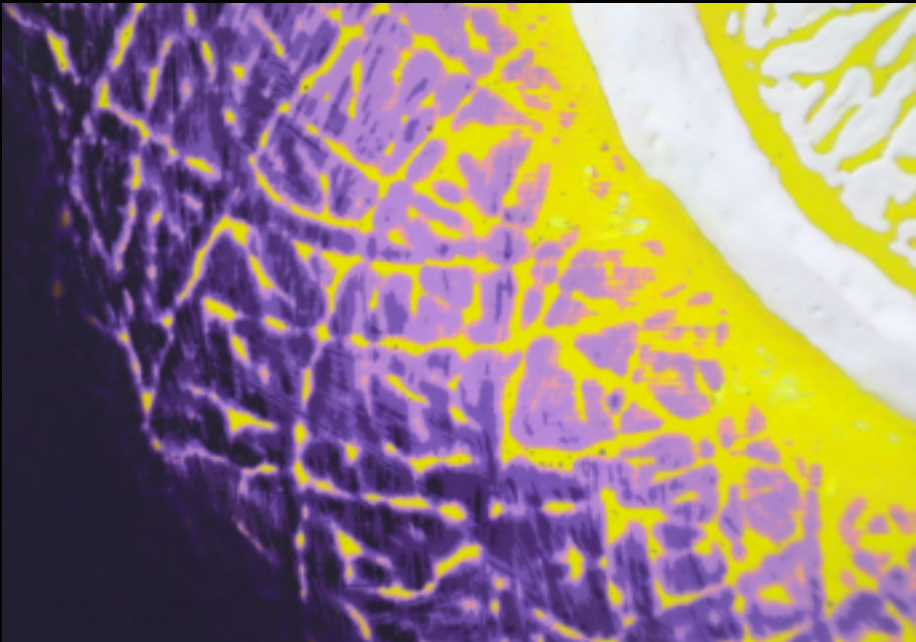
Otherwise, it becomes impossible to maintain the conditions to support life,

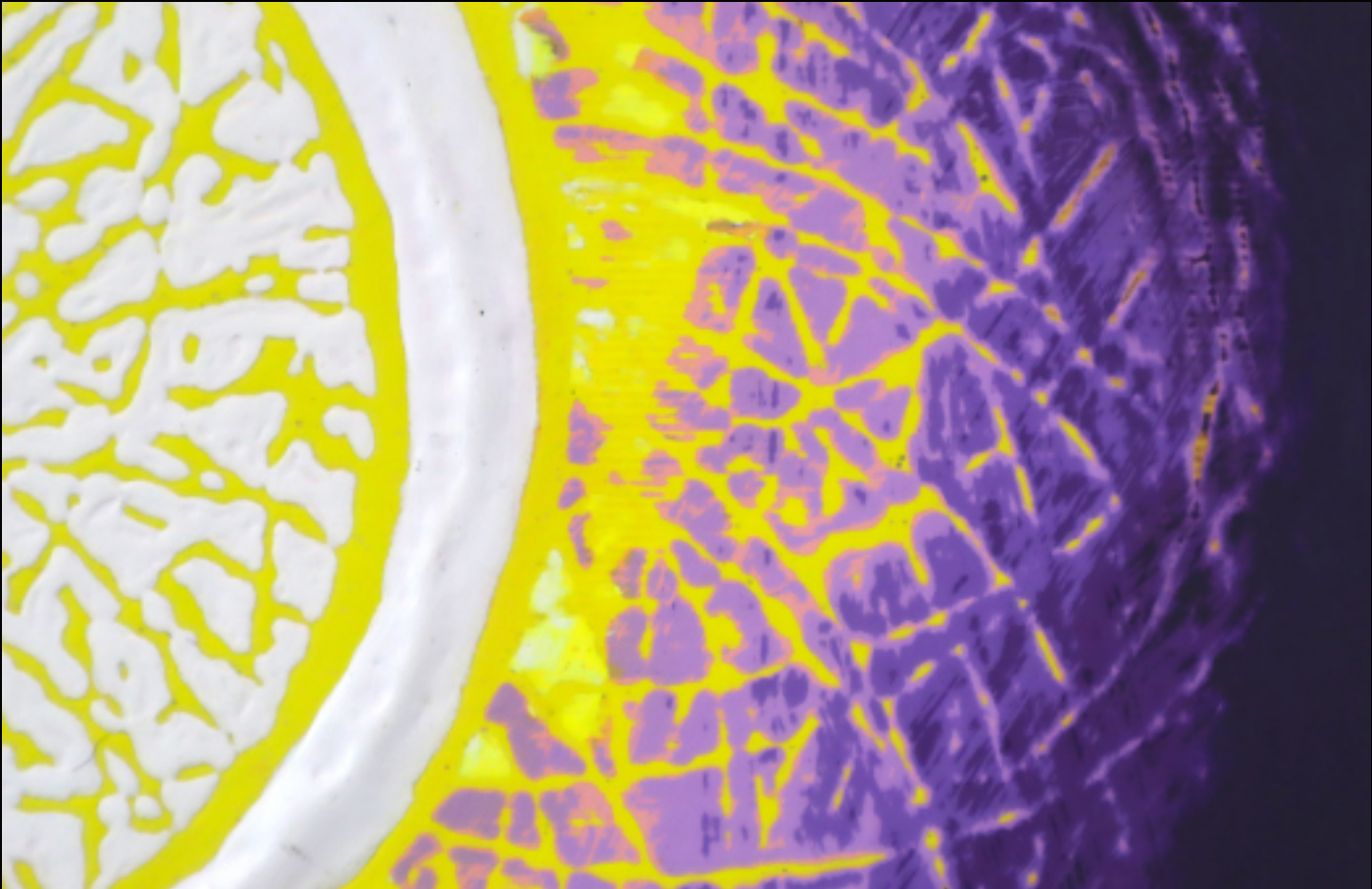

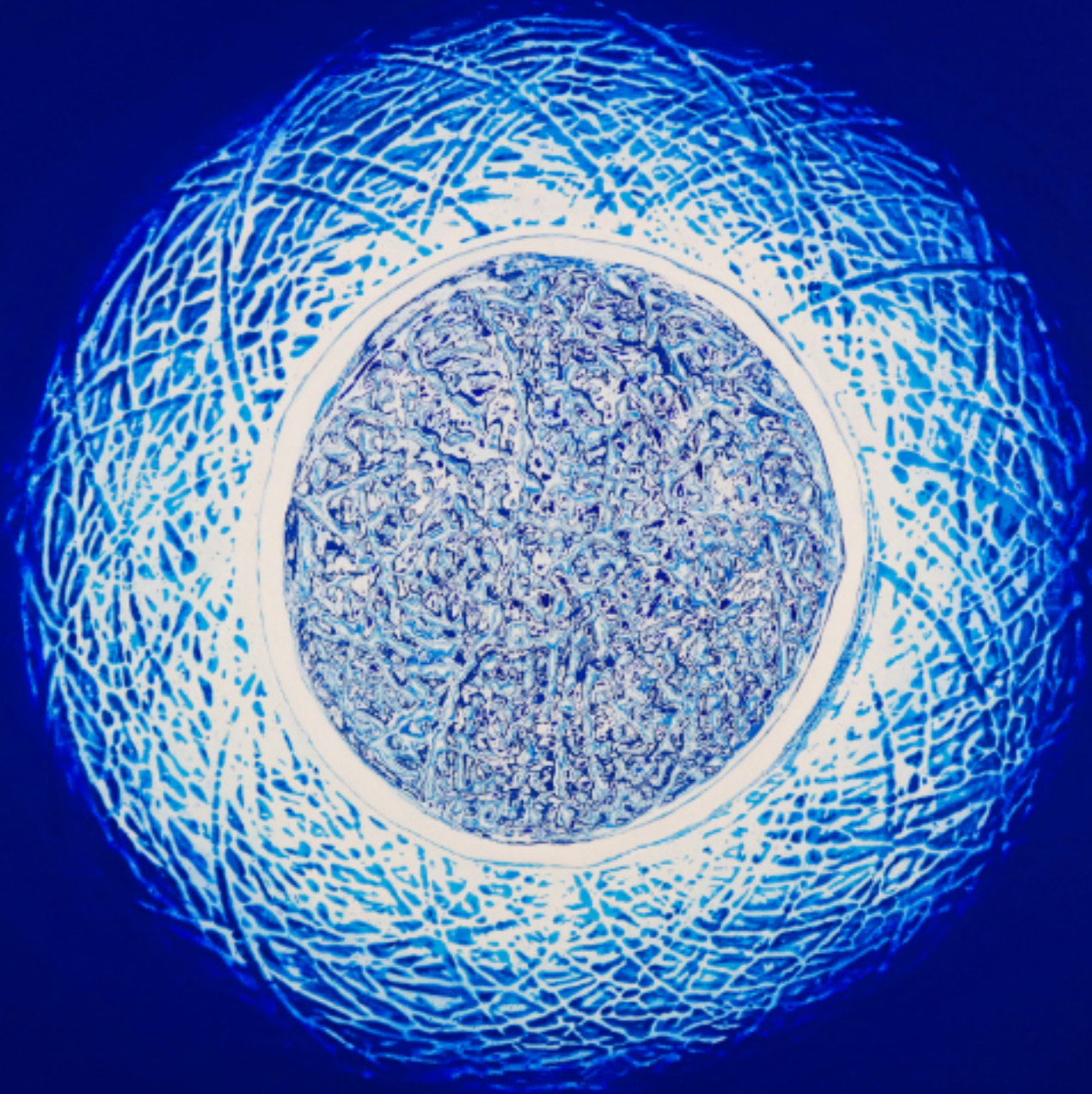

If the earth's rotational axis was prolonged in a line, it would eventually reach the North Star.

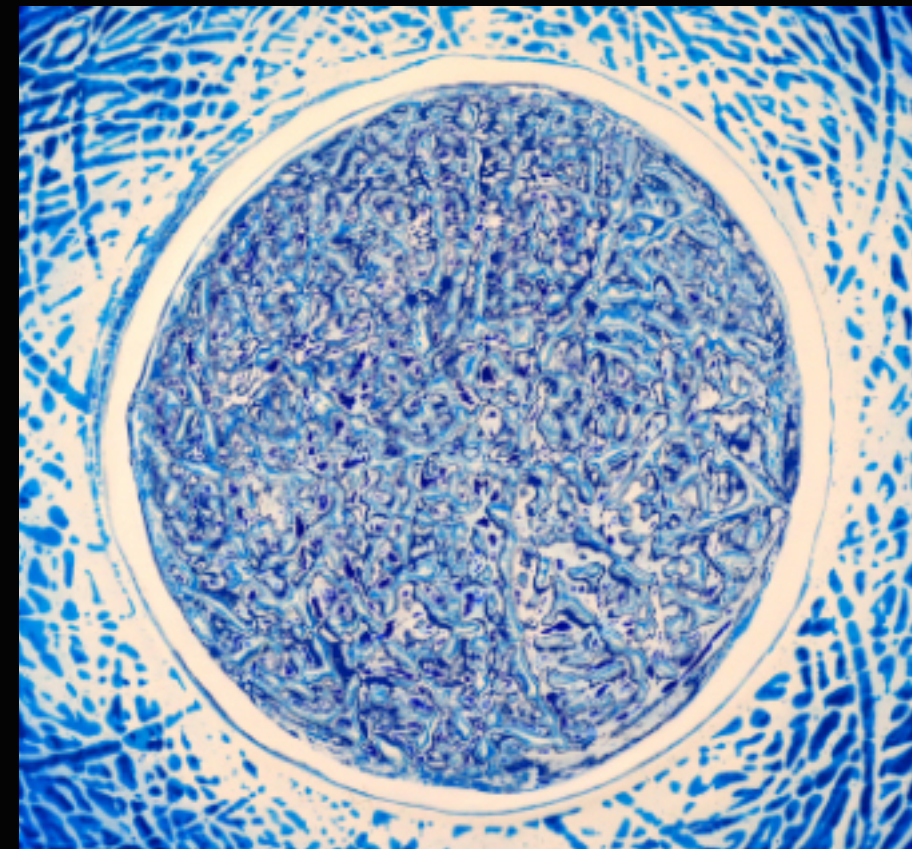
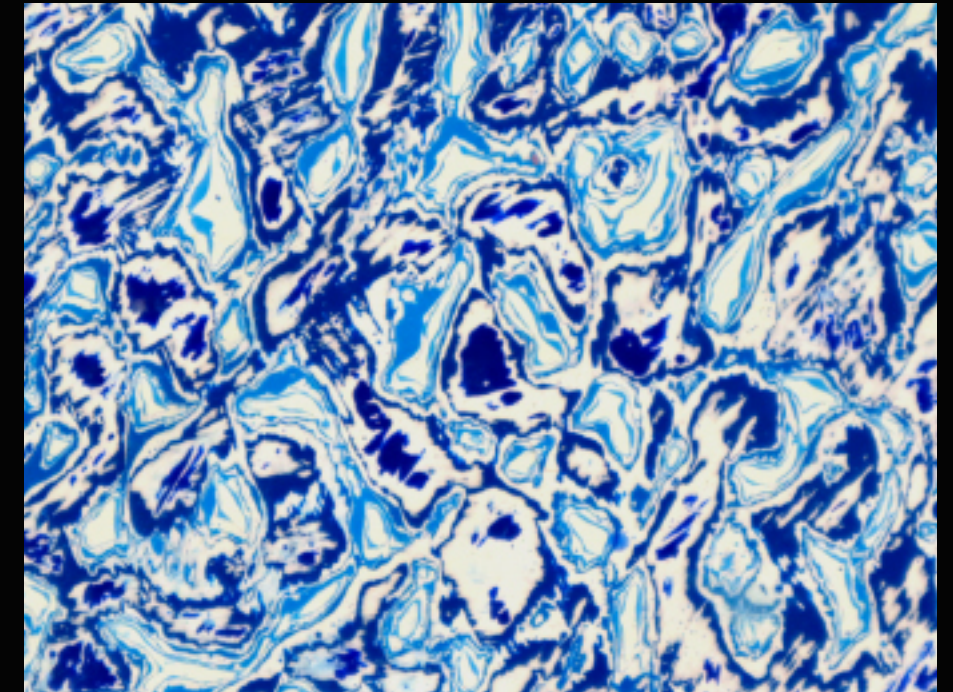
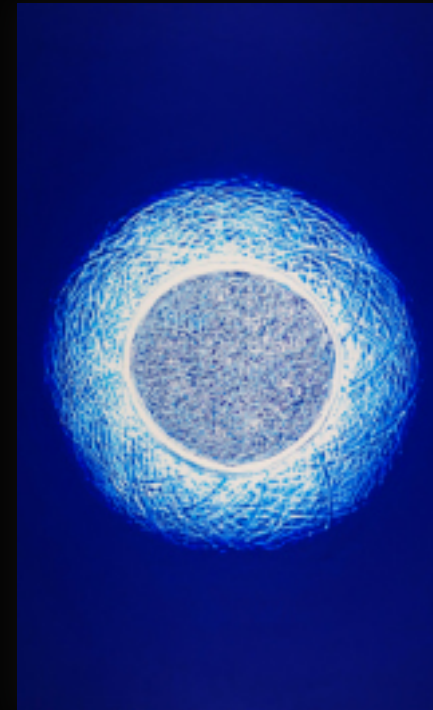

The only celestial object that does not move, was the one that allowed Humanity to travel around the globe.

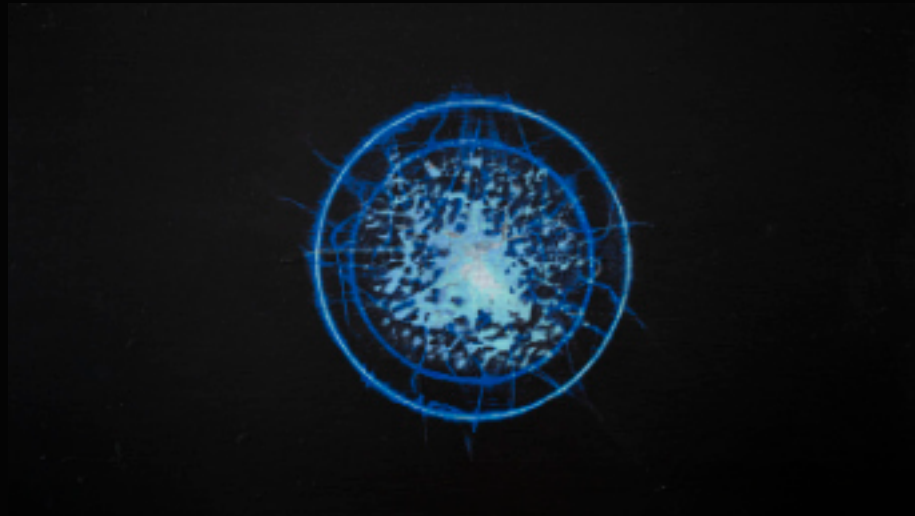
Used for centuries to reveal the true north, guiding sailors and explorers across the unknown, Polaris is the second most important star in our sky, after the Sun, of course.

MEET THE ARTIST

Nepomuceno's artistic drive is an expression of his main pursue as a human being: spiritual depth.

Raised with buddhist mentors since the age of six, spirituality has been the cornerstone of all personal growth throughout Nepomuceno's life.

And painting has always been the expression of his spirit.

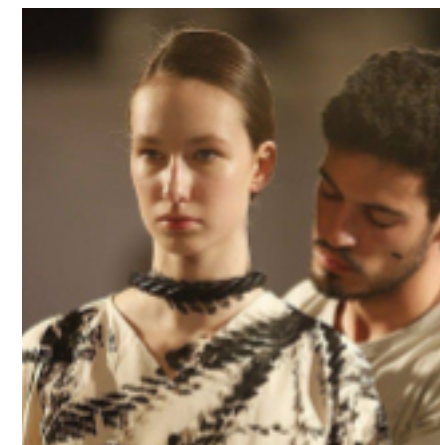
Graduated Painting in Lisbon's University of Fine Arts in 2015 with a fully developed abstract style, which has matured through his first individual and collective exhibitions, while in college.

Nepomuceno's abstract technique and conceptual depth has culminated in 2014 with the winning of a university-wide creative award.

Immediately after graduating, Nepomuceno's career took an international approach, exhibiting in England, and twice in Brazil.

While consistently developing his unique style, Nepomuceno has exhibited more than 20 times, has been awarded the 2016 Breakthrough Artist, by the Portuguese gallery Contemporary Arts Movement, and has been present in several private collections across the world.

In 2017 Nepomuceno's iconic live performance in Lisbon Fashion Week was featured in Vogue Japan.

From mid 2018 on, due to an overwhelming work schedule and increasing demand of his paintings, Nepomuceno realized that his painting technique was not overshadowing the depth of his conceptual creation, since it was not being able to express the spiritual journey he was experiencing, and therefore, not fulfilling the creative criteria he demands from his work.

So, Nepomuceno decided to invest in developing his writing skills, collaborating with cultural magazines, and gaining the skillset required to work with advertising agencies, as a copywriter.

Which he did, for 5 years, during which he learnt how to create strong and audience-impacting concepts, as well as the skill of summarizing complex subjects into engaging and simple language, without compromising their intellectual depth.



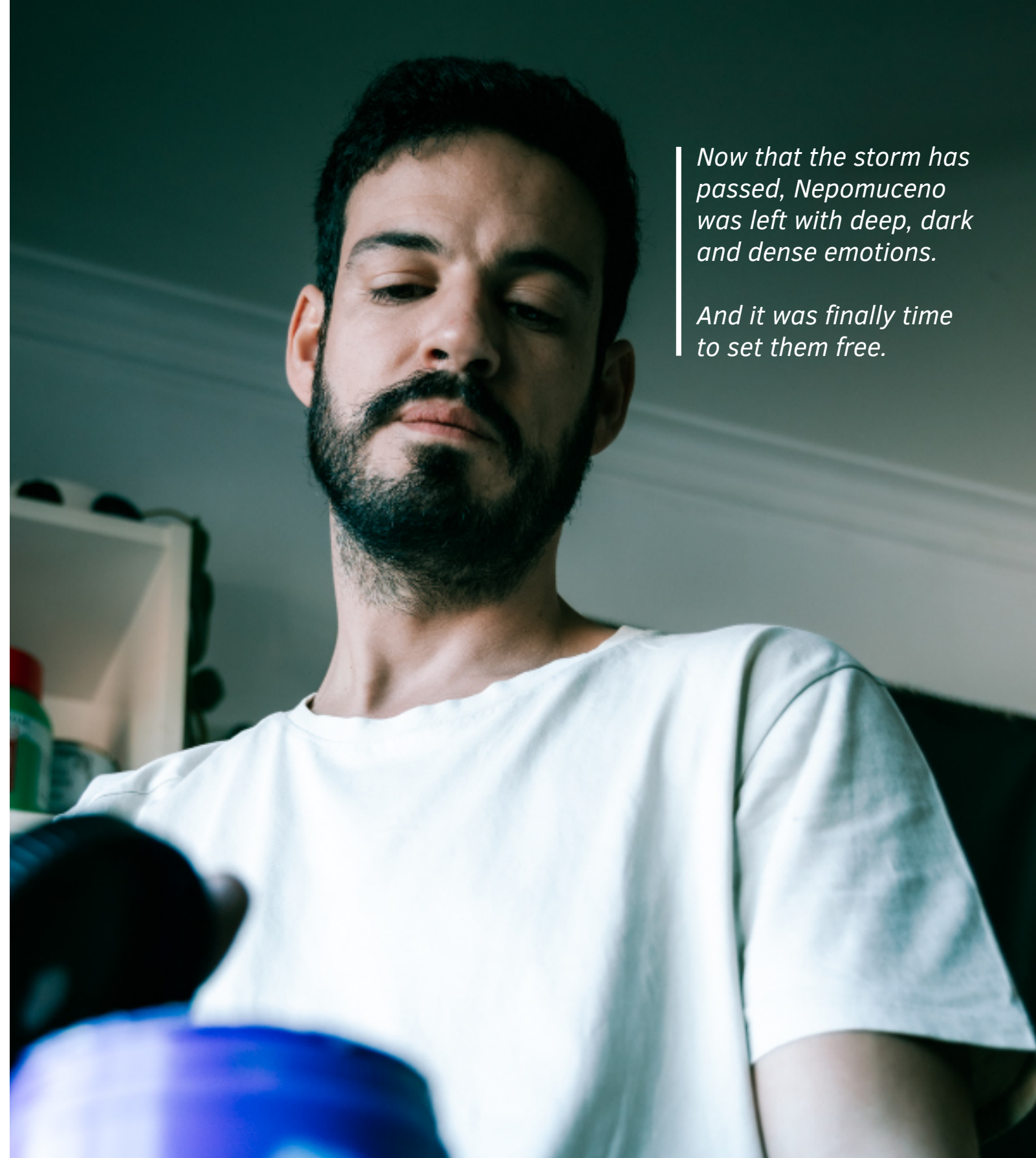

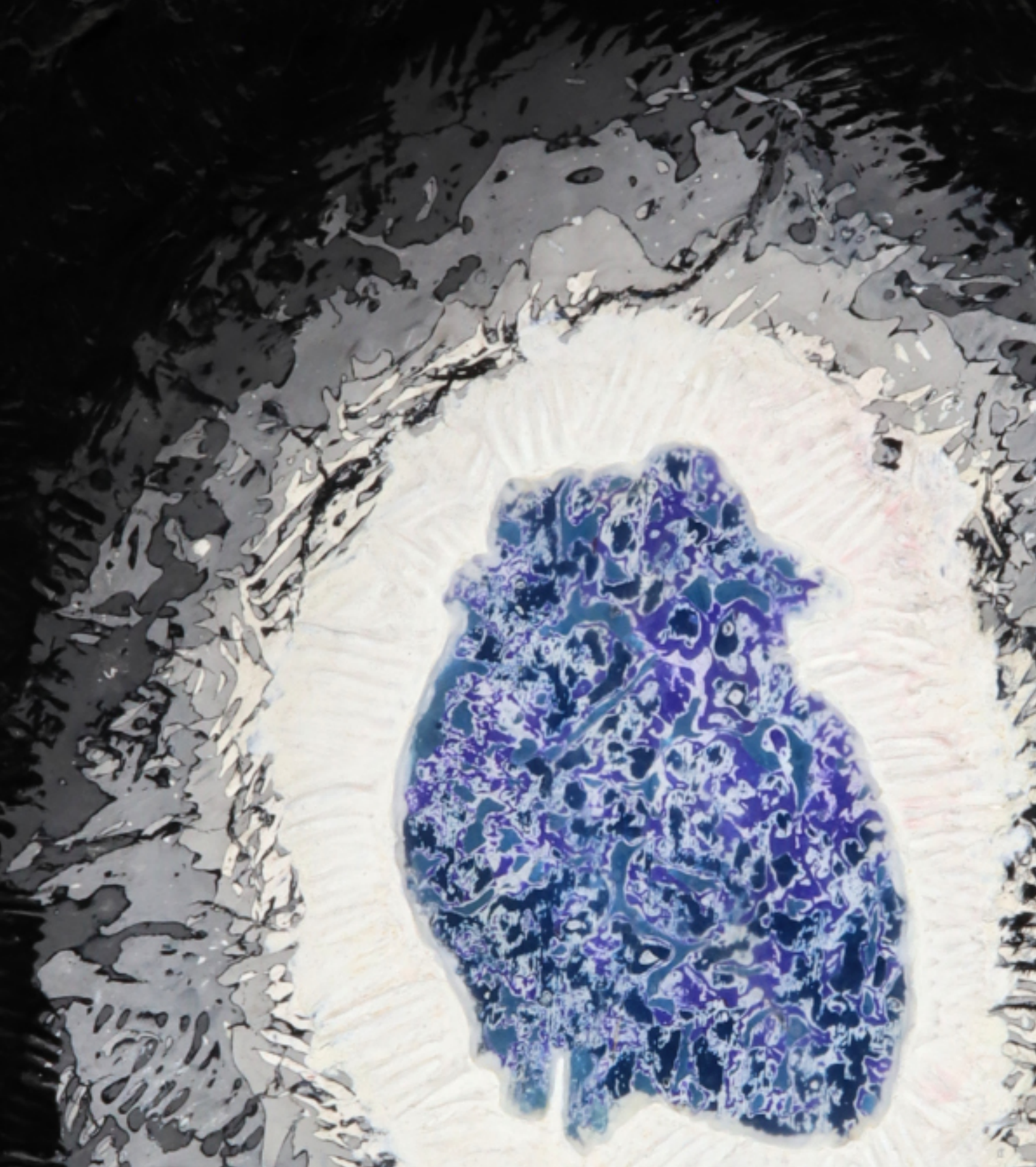
During those copywriting years, death and suffering have afflicted Nepomuceno, through the death of his stepmother, aunt, grandmother, and father, as well as sickness to his mother, and himself.

During those long, dark years, Nepomuceno had to endure, channeling his inner strength to care for his family members, while neglecting his own emotions.

Now that the storm has passed, Nepomuceno was left with deep, dark and dense emotions.

And it was finally time to set them free.





CONCEPT

EXPLORING DEPTH

“The main purpose of my artistic pursuit, is to create an experience, so impactful and profound, that has the insightful depth of an epiphany.”

Depth is the common denominator spread across Nepomuceno's work.

More than two decades of spiritual research through meditation practice, religious studies, and buddhist spiritual retreats have deepened Nepomuceno's insight and sharpened his sensitivity.

And four years of intimate relationships with Death, have awakened profound and dense emotions that seek outward expression.

The results are piercing abstract paintings that evoke experiences of primordial connection to the deepest aspects of our inner being, inducing a feeling of vulnerability, empathy, and belonging.

Nepomuceno's art is an hybrid of both a mirror and a well.

It is a token of both reflection, and immersion.

TECHNIQUE

OPENING WOUNDS

Nepomuceno's painting process expresses his conceptual desire to make visible the deeper layers of our inner

As the artist has experienced, that process often comes from suffering. However, it does not come from pain alone, but by the curiosity to explore what's beneath suffering.

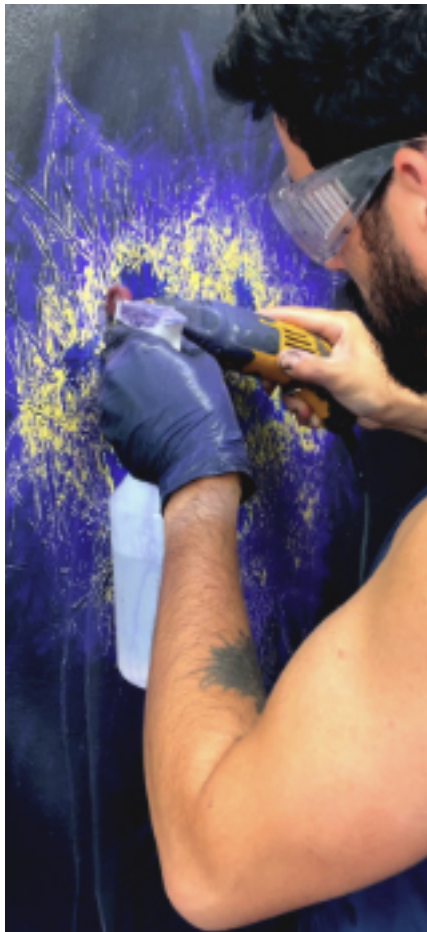
Pain compels us to look away.

Curiosity invites us to look inside.

So, Nepomuceno's technique reflects both the pain that life inflicts on humans, and our innate curiosity to look beneath the surface.

After creating an, either organic or geometrical texture, Nepomuceno adds several layers of acrylic paint.

And, like an archaeologist, the artist will use abrasive instruments to reveal the deeper textures and colors that exist beneath the surface.
